Mowrer was a perfect 6-0 (3-0 at #3 singles, 3-0 with John McLane at #2 doubles) as the Bison went 2-1 last week, falling to Franciscan-Steubenville (3-6) before earning 5-4 decisions against Marietta and PAC rival Thomas More. He dropped just

The Bison got the new season underway last week by winning two of their three matches, including their PAC opener ... The year started with a 6-3 loss to Franciscan, despite wins from **Greg Mowrer** (third) and **Bill Grant** (fifth) in

singles ... Bethany rallied from a 2-1 deficit after doubles to grab a 5-4 victory over Marietta Thursday ... Mowrer won both his matches again, as did **John McLane** at second singles and doubles with Mowrer ... Other wins came from **Andrew McPherson** at first singles and **Kyle Hughes** at fifth singles ... Bethany then topped Thomas More 5-4 on Saturday, as **David Hayes** picked up wins at sixth singles and third doubles.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City swept Saint Vincent Tuesday in the first meeting between the teams since 1990 ... All six Grove City players – Chris Baker, Peter Davis, Bill DeRocha, Jeremy Dwyer, Kyle Johnson and Shaun Mills –

Thomas More Saints

Thomas More opened its Presidents' Athletic Conference portion of the schedule with a resounding 8-1 win

over Washington & Jefferson ... In a loss to Bethany, the Saints dropped four of the last five singles matches ... Senior **Michael Selm** went unbeaten for the week, with 6-4, 6-1 and 6-3, 6-0 wins in first singles and 8-2, 8-2 wins in first doubles ... His doubles partner **Joe Ruzick** was also unbeaten for the week with 6-2, 3-6, 6-2 and 6-1, 6-0 wins ... Junior **David Sheeley** won both his fourth singles matches by scores of 6-4, 7-6 (7-5) and 6-4, 6-2.

all six singles matches in straight sets ... In singles play, the Bobcats controlled the match, winning eight sets by a score of 6-0 ... Waynesburg was scheduled to open PAC play with a home match on Thursday against Washington & Jefferson, but the match was postponed due to weather and has been rescheduled for April 17.



Westminster Titans

Westminster picked up its first win of the season Tuesday by beating Hiram, 7-2, in an indoor match held at the North Beaver Tennis Center in New Castle, Pa. ...
