Grove City did not drop a set in either win ... It's a busy week for Grove City as the Wolverines host five total matches this week, starting with a non-conference clash with Allegheny Tuesday ... Monday's home match with Waynesburg has been moved to Friday ... Grove City caps the week with a PAC match against Westminster before facing Penn State Altoona at noon.
