Davis was a perfect 8-0 (4-0 at #1 singles, 3-0 at #2 doubles, 1-0 at #1 doubles) last week, leading the Wolverines to a 4-0 dual record with 9-0 sweeps against all four opponents, including PAC foes Bethany and W&J.

Also nominated was senior **Greg Mowrer** of Bethany, freshman **Christopher Faulk** of Washington & Jefferson, freshman **Jeff Canning** of Waynesburg, and freshman **Fred Romeo** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S TENNIS NOTES



Bethany Bison

Bethany dropped a trio of matches last week, including a 9-0 PAC setback to 16-time defending champion Grove City ... The Bison led 2-1 after doubles play against Saint Vincent, but the Bearcats rallied with four wins in singles to claim the match ... **Greg Mowrer** teamed with **John McLane** for a doubles win, then scored a straight-set win in singles (6-1, 6-3), while **Bill Grant** tallied the other singles victory ... Against Notre Dame, **Joe McLane** and **Kyle Hughes** picked up an 8-3 win at #2 doubles and Mowrer (6-2, 6-0), Joe McLane (6-2, 6-2) and Hughes (6-4, 7-5) recorded wins at second, third and fourth singles, respectively, but it wasn't enough to defeat the Falcons.



Grove City Wolverines

Head coach **Joe Walters** earned his 300th win as men's tennis coach Friday as Grove City rolled to a 9-0 win at Penn State-Altoona ... In 35 years as men's head coach, Walters is now 301-113 ... Including his one season as women's coach, Walters owns a 312-114 overall tennis coaching record ... Grove City won all four matches last week by 9-0 scores, including conference wins over Bethany and W&J ... All five of Grove City's wins during its current streak have been by 9-0 scores ... Grove City dropped just one set during the week ... The Wolverines are 15-2 overall in their last 17 matches ... Grove City has won seven straight on the road.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More lost its second straight PAC match, falling to Waynesburg, 6-3 ... Senior **Michael Selm** and freshman **Joe Ruzick** continued their winning ways in singles as they remained unbeaten with a 6-3, 6-2 win and 2-6, 7-6, 6-2 win in first and second singles, respectively ... **Ryan Thompson**, in third singles, was the only other victory for the Saints – winning 6-3, 6-3 ... The duo of Selm and Ruzick lost for the first time in doubles competition, dropping a 8-3 decision.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson snapped an 18-match losing streak dating back to the 2005 season after posting a 6-3 victory over Westminster on Saturday ... The Presidents were led by freshman **Christopher Faulk** who earned wins at No. 1 singles and No. 1 doubles ... Junior **Jeff Tomaino** recorded victories in No. 2 singles and No. 1 doubles, while senior **Eric Magliocca** also posted a 2-0 record after winning at No. 4 singles and No. 3 doubles ... Sophomore **Matthew Varacallo** also claimed a victory at No. 5 singles ... Faulk notched a 2-1 record during the week in singles and doubles play.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets snapped their four-match losing streak in impressive fashion last week, edging Marietta 5-4 Thursday before winning their PAC opener Friday against Thomas More, 6-3 ... Sophomore **Kevin Houseknecht** and senior **Bryan McAnulty** each claimed a pair of wins against the Pioneers, including an 8-1 victory at No. 1 doubles ... Sophomore **Dustin Cozad** clinched the Waynesburg win with a 6-3, 6-2 victory at sixth singles ... Against the Saints, freshman **Jeff Canning** led the team with a pair of wins, including an impressive three-set victory at No. 4 singles over **Justin Egan** ... The Yellow Jackets won all three doubles match against TMC to take an early 3-0 lead.



Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's tennis team posted a 1-2 record last week ... The Titans (2-5, 0-1) cruised to an 8-1 non-conference win over Pitt-Greensburg Monday before losing a non-conference match against Frostburg State, 9-0, at home Friday and a PAC match at Washington & Jefferson, 6-3, Saturday ... Freshman **Fred Romeo** posted a combined record of 4-2 in the three matches at No. 3 singles and No. 2 doubles with junior teammate **Dusty Rhodes** ... Romeo beat W&J in straight sets (6-1, 6-2) and joined Rhodes to win 8-3 in doubles play ... Freshman **Scott Lawrence** also gave Westminster a point against W&J, winning in straight sets (6-4, 6-0) ... Romeo leads the team with a 3-4 singles record and a 3-3 doubles mark with Rhodes ... Lawrence is 2-2 in singles.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat netters went 2-1 last week, topping PAC rivals Washington & Jefferson (6-3) and Bethany (5-4) before falling to non-league foe Penn State-Altoona (6-3) ... Saint Vincent does not return to the courts until April 13.
