Bethany Bison

The Bison went 0-2 last week and came up just short of its first win in two years with a 5-4 loss to Notre Dame (Ohio) on Monday ... In that match, Bethany received wins from freshman twin brothers, Joe and John McLane, in second and third singles, and they also combined to win second doubles ... Pat Green and Tyler Kowcheck also won at first doubles to account for the four Bison points ... Against Westminster, Joe McLane notched the lone victory, winning second doubles.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson remained undefeated after edging Waynesburg, 6-3, in Presidents' Athletic Conference men's tennis action on Sunday at the Peters Township Indoor Tennis Center ... The match was postponed twice this week due to rain, but was finally staged on Sunday in an indoor facility ... Sophomores Ali Nemazee and Doug Johnston led W&J to the victory by claiming both their singles and double matches ... Washington & Jefferson returns to action on Tuesday as it hosts Westminster in a PAC match at 3:00 pm at the Janet L. Swanson Tennis Courts.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City rattled off three straight victories this week, including a 4-3 win over Hartwick in Hilton Head, S.C. ... Four of the six singles matches against Hartwick went three sets ... Andrew Geisler was Grove City's lone double-winner against Hartwick ... Phil Springirth and Brock Thompson both earned two wins indoors against Frostburg State, as did Geisler ... Sophomore Sam Fortna notched two wins in Grove City's 9-0 victory over PAC rival Thiel last Wednesday afternoon at home ... Grove City has won 22 of its last 24 matches.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg suffered two losses over the weekend to start PAC play ... The Jackets opened with a 6-3 loss to Westminster before suffering another 6-3 loss to W&J Sunday ... No. 1 singles Matt Otis recorded a team-high three wins over the weekend ... Otis needed only two sets to defeat both No. 1 seeds, Ehren Frey of W&J and Mark Gross of Westminster ... Otis joined Joe Koch to defeat the No. 2 doubles seed of Westminster ... The doubles win was one of only two Waynesburg recorded this weekend, the other being the No. 3 doubles team of juniors Ryan Floyd and Nate Smucker against W&J. ... Both players struggled in singles play over the weekend dropping three matches.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men's tennis team finished the week 0-2 with both losses coming to Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) opponents, falling 2-7 at Westminster on Monday and 0-9 at Grove City on Wednesday ... Sophomores **Brian Gowday** and **Dennis Wright** improved to 4-1 at number one doubles on the season with their 8-6 victory over the Titans' **Mark Gross** and **Ryan Mistovich**, while freshman **Keith Williams** ran his number two singles record to 4-1 by defeating **John Libert** 6-2, 6-2.

Westminster Titans

Westminster went 3-1 last week, sweeping PAC matches against Thiel (7-2), Bethany (8-1) and Waynesburg (6-3) before falling to NAIA Roberts Wesleyan (8-1) ...
