Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverine men ran their winning streak to nine matches with a 3-0 week last week ... Wolverines won 26 of 27 matches last week, including a pair of 9-0 sweeps in PAC action ... Grove City's first doubles tandem of Patrick Donahue and Brent Moon remained undefeated as did the second doubles combination of Phil Springirth and Matthew Chung ... Andrew Geisler remained unbeaten at sixth singles ... During the nine-match win streak, Grove City has won by an aggregate score of 78-3 ... Wolverines visit Washington and Jefferson and Frostburg State this week before closing season with four straight home matches, including three against scholarship programs.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets
