Bethany Bison

The Bison put up a tough fight but dropped three matches last week ... The Marietta contest was highlighted by **Dustin Opalka** and **Andrew McPherson** recording two wins, as they teamed for an 8-2 win at #1 doubles ... In singles

play, Opalka (6-3, 6-4) and McPherson (6-1, 6-3) also won in straight sets at #1 and #2 ... BC came up just short in pursuit of their first win Friday with a 5-4 loss to Thomas More ... McPherson, who also won his singles match, and Opalka claimed an 8-6 victory at first doubles ... **Mike Aivalis** (6-7, 6-2, 10-2) and **Brad Burkhart** (6-1, 7-5) were also victorious at fourth and fifth singles respectively ... Against Westminster, Opalka (6-3, 4-6, 6-4) and Aivalis (6-4, 6-4) pulled their singles records to .500 with wins.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City ran its win streak to five last week with a trio of wins ... Each of the five wins during the streak has been a shutout ... Against Saint Vincent, **John Moyer** and **Peter Davis** both picked up 6-0, 6-0 wins in

singles play, then teamed for an 8-1 first doubles victory ... Moyer also posted a 6-0, 6-0 win at No. 1 singles against Westminster Saturday ... Overall, Grove City did not drop a set in either match against PAC foes last week ... Grove City has won at least 10 matches in 15 out of the last 18 seasons ... The Wolverines will visit Carnegie Mellon Monday before hosting Allegheny Thursday afternoon in a makeup match ... Grove City returns to PAC action next Saturday at Thomas More.
