Grove City College 5-8 freshman - #2 singles Erie, Pa./Harborcreek H.S.

Springirth earned PAC Player of the Week honors after posting a 2-1 mark at #2 singles for the Wolverines, including a 2-0 mark in PAC competition with wins over W&J and Waynesburg. He now has a 10-4 singles mark this season, including 8-3 at #2 singles.

Bethany Bison

After being blanked by PSU-Altoona Monday, Bethany dropped a 7-2 decision to Waynesburg ... Senior **Dominic Costa** teamed with freshman **Patrick Greene** for a win at #1 doubles and then claimed his match at #1 singles ... At #4, senior **John Joyce** lost in two tough sets, while senior **Tom Moore** was edged in a threeset decision at #6 ... Against West Liberty, Costa picked up the only win at #1 singles for the Green and White, delivering a 6-3, 4-6, 6-4 win over West Liberty's **Amos Allison**.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson had its five-match winning streak snapped this past week as it dropped close contests to Westminster, Grove City and Penn State-Behrend ... Junior Matt Yokitis posted the squad's best record at No. 2 singles by going 2-1, falling only to Grove City's Phil Springirth (6-3, 6-2) ... He also teamed with junior Jordan Genis to win their No. 1 doubles match over GCC, 8-0 ... The No. 3 doubles combination on senior Francis Burt and junior Shahin Nemazee won both of their matches this week, defeating Grove City and Westminster.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines moved to 10-4 overall and 4-0 against league opponents after defeating Washington & Jefferson and Waynesburg last week ... Grove City has won 9 of its last 11 matches ... Sophomore **Patrick Donahue** added two straight-set victories against PAC opponents to improve to 11-3 at first singles.
