#### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison continued to build momentum towards PAC Championships with 6-3 wins over Franciscan and W&J before having a home meet against Frostburg State cancelled by rain ... Bethany swept all three doubles matches

against Franciscan and then clinched the match with victories at fourth, fifth and sixth singles ... Against W&J, Greg Mowrer powered the Bison to the win with an 8-2 victory at #2 doubles with John McLane and then a 6-4, 6-4 triumph at third singles ... The W&J win was Bethany's third PAC victory of the year, their most since they went 4-0 in 1999, and the five overall triumphs is the most by a weekend at the conference championships. Bison team since they went 8-7 in 2000.
