Hadricky was a perfect 4-0 on the week, leading the Titans to PAC wins over Washington & Jefferson (5-4) and Bethany (6-3). He clinched the one-point W&J win with a 6-4, 6-0 win at fourth singles, while his win at fifth singles against the Bison gave him a team-high nine singles wins this season.

Also nominated was junior **John McLane** of Bethany, junior **Keith Williams** of Thiel, senior **Gary Tan** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman **Kevin Houseknecht** of Waynesburg.

Down a player at Westminster, Bethany was forced to forfeit #3 doubles and #6 singles and it came back to haunt them in a 6-3 loss to the Titans ... The **McLane** brothers posted a perfect day, as **John** and **Joe** won 8-2 at #1 doubles ... In singles, John picked up a 7-5, 7-5 triumph at #1 and Joe rolled to a 6-3, 6-1 win at #2.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City was off during Easter break last week ... The Wolverines will visit NAIA Malone Wednesday in a final tune-up for the PAC Championships ... Grove City is seeking its 16th straight conference title ... The Wolverines will close the 2006 season at Slippery Rock April 25.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 2-0 with a pair of PAC victories ... Thiel dealt Bethany a 9-0 loss Monday before defeating W&J 8-1 Thursday ... Against Bethany, senior **Brian Gowday** went 2-0, posting a 6-2, 6-3 win at number one singles and teaming with junior **Keith Williams**

for an 8-3 win at first doubles ... Williams recorded a 6-0, 6-1 win at number two singles ... Junior **Geno Bianco** won 6-2, 6-0 at number three singles, and, along with freshman **Tyler Ochs**, earned a default win at number three doubles ... Ochs picked up a 6-0, 6-0 win at fourth singles ... Freshman **Blake Betteridge** and junior **Mark Coney** won 9-7 at second doubles ... Betteridge won by default at sixth singles while senior **Zach Richards** posted win at fifth singles.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents dropped a close 5-4 decision to Westminster on Tuesday and then were handed an 8-1 setback at Thiel two days later ... In the loss to the Titans, the Presidents were led by seniors **Gary Tan** and **Matt Riddle** and sophomore **Jeff Tomaino**, who all recorded singles victories ... Tan and Tomaino also combined for an 8-1

victory at No. 1 doubles to round out the Presidents' scoring ... Tan was the only President to garner a point at Thiel and he has now claimed six of his last eight singles matches ... Tan improved his record in conference action to 5-1.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg finished the PAC portion of its schedule with 8-1 victory over Bethany Tuesday before defeating Penn State-Altoona Thursday, 6-3 ... In both matches last week, the Yellow Jackets swept all three doubles contests ... Junior **Bryan McAnulty** moved up to No. 1 singles against the Bison and cruised to a 6-2, 6-2 win, while classmate **Joe Koch** swept his match at the second spot, 6-0, 6-0, against Bethany ... Freshman **Kevin Houseknecht** registered a perfect 4-0 record last week, including two wins against PSU-Altoona ... Junior **Matt Otis** returned to his traditional No. 1 singles position against the Lions and cruised to a 6-0, 6-2 victory ... Freshman **Dustin Cozad** won both his matches at the sixth slot for Waynesburg last week.



Westminster Titans

The Titan netters evened their PAC mark at 3-3 after league wins at Washington & Jefferson (5-4) and at home vs. Bethany (6-3) ... At W&J, both teams captured three singles contests, but Westminster won two of the three doubles matchups ... Three Titans were double winners against the Presidents ... Freshman **Stefan Hadricky** was victorious at fourth singles and at second doubles with sophomore **Gene Cunningham** ... The freshman duo of **Nate Dodd** and **J.D. Eicher** captured third doubles while adding wins at fifth and sixth

singles, respectively ... Cunningham and Hadricky also posted double wins vs. Bethany ... The Titans also got wins from senior **Ryan Mistovich** at third singles and a pair of forfeit victories.
