Washington & Jefferson College

Sophomore - #3 singles/#2 doubles Great Falls, Va./Langley H.S.

Nemazee won all three of his singles matches to improve to 10-0 on the season, while also claiming both of his doubles matches including a dramatic 9-8 (4) win with **Doug Johnston** over NCAA Division II Slippery Rock.

Also nominated was junior **Phil Springirth** of Grove City, freshman **Keith Williams** of Thiel, freshman **Bryan McAnulty** of Waynesburg, and senior **John Libert** of Westminster.

:The Bison lost to Westminster in its only match last week by a score of 5-4 ... The other scheduled match against Pitt Greensburg was canceled ... The Bison won three games by forfeit against the Titans and received a win from **Brian Cerullo** in fourth singles, as he defeated **Ryan Mistovich**, 6-1, 6-3.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J posted one of its biggest wins in recent years after breezing past Slippery Rock, 8-1, Saturday ... The Presidents' No. 1 doubles team of senior Ehren Frey and sophomore Gary Tan trailed 5-2 early on before coming back to claim a 9-7 victory ... Sophomores Ali Nemazee, who is a perfect 10-0 on the season at No. 3 singles, and **Doug Johnston** also were trailing 7-4 at No. 2 doubles and facing a triple-match point before rallying back for a 9-8 (4) win ... W&J won four of the five contested singles matches and also claimed both doubles contests in the victory over Frostburg State on Friday ... W&J and Penn State-Altoona split six singles matches on Thursday; however, the Lions earned the win by claiming two of the three doubles contests.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City reached double-digits in victories for the fourth consecutive year and for the 12th time in 14 years Friday with a win at Westminster ... Grove City recorded straight-set wins in five of six singles matches and swept all six singles matches ... The Wolverines did not lose a set at Waynesburg Thursday, improving to 4-0 in the conference ... At Allegheny Wednesday, Brock Thompson and Phil Springirth both earned singles victories to account for Grove City's two points ... Grove City has matches at Malone and Slippery Rock remaining on the schedule ... The Wolverines will look to claim their 14th straight conference title this weekend in Erie.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg won its 10th match of the season with an 8-1 win over Thiel on Saturday, just two days after a 9-0 loss to Grove City ... Freshman No. 3 singles **Bryan McAnulty** earned his team-best 12th singles win of the season against Thiel's **Dennis Wright** in straight sets ... All singles matches Waynesburg won in straight sets ... In doubles, No. 3 **Ryan Floyd** and **Nate Smucker** won their team-best ninth doubles win of the season with an 8-1 win ... Against Grove City, freshman No. 1 singles **Matt Otis** lost to reigning PAC MVP **Patrick Donahue** 7-5, 6-1.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats losing streak now stands at five after suffering defeats by Westminster (3-6) and Waynesburg (1-8) last week ... Freshman Keith Williams won his number two singles match with a 6-4, 6-1 win over the Titans' Corey Sacca while fellow freshman Geno Bianco also bettered his season mark to 5-2 at number four singles, defeating Westminster's Sam Seo 2-6, 6-4, (10-7), by taking the third-set tiebreaker ... Sophomore Brian Gowday earned a 6-2, 6-3 win at number one singles by defeating Westminster's Mark Gross ... Williams improved to 6-2 on the season at his number two singles spot by defeating the Yellow Jacket's Jon Crossley.

Westminster Titans

The Titans netters went 2-1 last week, topping Bethany (5-4) and Thiel (6-3) in non-league matches before suffering their first PAC defeat at home to Grove City (8-1) ... At Bethany, the brother duo of senior John Libert and sophomore Ben Libert led the way, winning at #1 and #3 singles, respectively, while also teaming for a win at #1 doubles ... Junior Dave Molitor was also a double winner, capturing #2 singles while teaming with sophomore Ryan Mistovich at #2 doubles ... The Liberts won at #3 and #6 singles, respectively, while teaming for a win at #3 doubles at Thiel ... Molitor also won two matches, capturing #5 singles while teaming with classmate Sam Seo at #2 doubles ... The Liberts won at #3 doubles against Grove City.
