PAC MEN'S TENNIS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

EHREN FREY

Washington & Jefferson College Junior - #3-5 singles/#2 doubles Mt. Lebanon, Pa./Mt. Lebanon H.S.

Frey was a perfect 4-0 last week, helping W&J run its win streak to six matches with wins over Pitt-Greensburg (8-1) and PAC foe Waynesburg (8-1). He played up to #3 singles against UP-G and won at #5 singles against the Yellow jackets, while teaming with freshman **Gary Tan** for a pair of #2 doubles wins.

Also nominated was freshman **Jason Brun** of Bethany, freshman **Matthew Chung** of Grove City, and senior **Ryan Quallich** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S TENNIS NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped their final three regular season matches to finish the year at 0-12 ... Freshman **Zach Richards** won his only match of the year in three sets for Bethany's only win against Altoona ... In the match with Thiel, Bethany dropped two of three doubles matches, with **Eric Beeson** and **Cody Tyler** teaming for the 8-2 win at #3 ... In singles, **Brian Cerullo** (4-6, 6-0, 6-0), **Jason Brun** (6-2, 6-2) and **Eric Givens** (6-3, 6-3) picked up wins at #3, #5 and #6 but it wasn't enough for the Bison to avoid their 12th loss.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson extended its win streak to six matches this week with 8-1 victories over Pitt-Greensburg and Waynesburg ... The Presidents have not dropped more than two points in six of their seven wins in 2003 ... Freshman Ali Nemazee moved to 7-0 in singles play with his 6-4, 6-3 win over Ryan Floyd over Waynesburg on Tuesday ... Junior Ehren Frey and freshman Gary Tan both have five consecutive singles matches ... Frey has also teamed with Tan for fivestraight victories at their No. 2 doubles position ... The Presidents face stern tests on the road on Monday and Tuesday by taking on Westminster and Grove City in preparing for this weekend's PAC Tournament.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines had their 11-match win streak end with a loss to NAIA power Walsh Monday ... Grove City bounced back the next day, however, with an 8-1 victory over Allegheny ... It was Grove City's first win over the Gators since 1993 ... Brent Moon, Phil Springirth, Geoff Gehring, Matthew Chung and Andrew Geisler all won singles matches against Allegheny ... Chung is now 13-0 in singles action, including a 12-0 mark at fifth singles ... Chung and Geisler accounted for the Wolverines' two victories against Walsh ... Grove City looks to complete a 5-0 mark against PAC foes Tuesday at W&J ... Grove City will look to wrap up its 13th consecutive PAC crown this weekend in Erie.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost decisively in its lone match of the week to Washington & Jefferson, 8-1 ... Mike Pamepinto won the first set at No. 2 singles against **Matt** Yokitus prior to dropping the second set, and rallied in the third to win the Jackets' lone match of the day ... Pamepinto and Eric Kaluza dropped the No. 1 doubles match 9-7 to the team of Jordan Genis and Yokitus ... Mark Gates was the only other Jacket to force his match to three sets ... Gates, playing at No. 4 singles, defeated Gary Tan in the second set before dropping the third set ... Gates teamed with Guillermo Pradera at No. 2 doubles and dropped the match 9-7 ... Waynesburg's match at Juniata on Thursday was cancelled.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men's tennis team picked up its first victory of the 2003 season last week, defeating PAC rival Bethany College 5-4 ... The Tomcats fell at Penn State Behrend 0-9 before getting their first win under first-year head coach Mike Snell ... The Tomcats opened up the match with wins in two of the three doubles matches against the Bison ... Freshmen Brian Gowday and Dennis Wright won their number one doubles match, while junior Bill Mullane teamed with freshman Eric Cagnoli to win at number two doubles ... Gowday also posted a three-set win at number one singles ... Wright took the second singles match in two sets, while Cagnoli notched his first collegiate win at third singles.

Westminster Titans

Westminster won a pair of non-conference matches against PAC opponents last week, winning at Thiel 7-2 on Tuesday before posting a 9-0 home win over Bethany on Wednesday ... WC has now won three straight matches to climb above .500 ... Three Titans were double winners at Thiel: sophomore Dave Molitor won at #4 singles and #2 doubles ... Also, the winning #3 doubles team of senior Ryan Quallich and freshman Shane McCullough won at #5 and #6 singles, respectively ... Five Titans were double winners against the Bison ... Junior John Libert and freshman Ben Libert won at #1 and #5 singles and #2 doubles ... Sophomores Mark Gross and Sammy Seo teamed at #1 doubles while winning #2 and #3 singles, respectively.
