Burt won both his matches for the Presidents in their 8-1 win over PAC rival Waynesburg last week, W&J's only match of the week. He posted a three-set win at #5 singles before teaming with **Shahin Nemazee** at #3 doubles.

## PAC MEN'S TENNIS NOTES

#### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison tasted victory for the first time this season with a 6-3 win over Marietta Thursday ... Senior **Dominic Costa** led the way with wins in doubles (8-1) and singles (6-3, 6-0) ... Freshman **Patrick Greene** shared the doubles triumph with Costa and picked up a 6-4, 6-0 win at #2 singles ... The tandem of **Eric Givens** and **Cody Tyler** were victorious at #2 doubles (9-7) and Tyler won his match at #3 singles (6-2, 6-3) ... The other victory was by **John Joyce** at #4 (6-0, 6-0).

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson snapped its three-match losing skid on Monday by defeating Waynesburg for the second time this season, 8-1 ... W&J claimed all three doubles matches and five of the six singles matches ... Matt Dubow, Ehren Frey, Francis Burt and Shahin Nemazee all won both their singles and doubles matches ... W&J takes on Thiel on Tuesday before trying to improve upon its second place finish at last season's PAC Championships on Friday.

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

The Wolverines split a pair of matches last week, falling at Allegheny before winning at Westminster ... Grove City equaled last season's win total with its 11th victory.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

For the third week in a row the Yellow Jackets split matches to remain at .500 on the season and .500 in the PAC ... The Jackets host Frostburg State on Monday before playing in the PAC Tournament at Grove City over the weekend.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men's tennis team dropped to 0-9 on the season this week with losses to Div. II Slippery Rock and PAC rival Waynesburg ... Thiel will host two PAC schools this week, W&J and Bethany, before participating in the conference tournament.

#### Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's tennis team split a pair of PAC contests, sweeping Bethany 9-0 on Tuesday before falling to league leader Grove City 6-3 on Thursday ... The Titans were poised for a possible upset of GCC by winning two of three doubles matches, but the Wolverines posted wins in five of the sixsingles contests ... Freshman Corey Sacca was the lone singles winner for WC at #5 ... Four Titans posted double wins against the Bison: senior Chuck Correll and sophomore John Libert won at #1 and #5 singles, respectively, while teaming for victory at #1 doubles ... Winning at #2 doubles was the freshman team of Mark Gross and Sacca, who also won at #3 and #4 singles, respectively.
