NEWS & NOTES: The unbeaten Grove City Wolverines had the week off and will put their perfect season on the line Tuesday vs. Allegheny in the final warmup for the 2011 PAC Men's Tennis Championships in Erie this weekend ... The 2011 PAC team champion will receive an automatic bid to the NCAA Championships for the first time in league history ... Bethany has won three straight matches and can clinch its first winning record since 1999 with a win at Waynesburg Tuesday ... **Andrew Hetzer** and **Evan Bryan** were doubles winners for Thomas More in a 6-3 PAC loss to Bethany ... Waynesburg won its only match of the week over PAC foe Thiel 8-1, as **David Floyd** earned his first collegiate career wins at #6 singles and third doubles ... Westminster had its final two non-league matches cancelled, while Saint Vincent had its only match with W&J rained out ... The Presidents will have their final try for a PAC win against the Bearcats on Tuesday.

PAC MEN'S TENNIS NOTES

Bethany Bison (6-6, 3-3 PAC)



After losing 9-0 at Muskingum to start the week, Bethany rolled off three straight wins and at 6-6, needs a win in the regular season finale at Waynesburg to clinch its first winning season since 1999 ... BC bounced back from losses at #1 doubles and the first two singles flights to defeat Thomas More 6-3 and even their PAC mark at 3-3 ... Big victories were earned by **Dustin Maiolo** at #4 and **Ryan Rokisky** at #5, both in three sets ... Bethany rolled to an 8-1 win over Mount Aloysius, with victories in all three doubles matches and five straight-set wins in singles ... The Bison improved to 6-6 by coasting past Pitt-Greensburg 9-0.

Grove City Wolverines (10-0, 7-0 PAC)



The Grove City College men's tennis team returns to action this week after being off for Easter Break ... Grove City hosts Allegheny Tuesday in non-conference action as the Wolverines aim for their first unbeaten regular season since 1965 ... Grove City is currently 10-0 for the first time since the 1965 squad went 11-0 ... Friday and Saturday, Grove City will compete in the conference championships in Erie, Pa. at the Pennbriar Club ... The Wolverines are pursuing their 21st straight league crown.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-6, 4-1 PAC)



Thanks to Mother Nature, the Bearcats lone event of the week, a Monday match at W&J, was postponed ... In second place in the PAC with a 4-1 conference mark, the team will now wrap up the regular season this week with PAC matches at Waynesburg (Monday) and Washington & Jefferson (Tuesday) before heading to Erie for the week-end PAC Championships.

Thiel Tomcats (1-11, 0-5 PAC)



Thiel's **Zach Kubec** won in both singles and doubles for the second straight match, but it wasn't enough as the Tomcats fell 6-3 to visiting Westminster in a PAC match Thursday ... Kubec defeated the Titans' **Sean Black**, 6-3, 6-3, for his third straight win at No. 4 singles ... He also teamed up with **Louie Rubin** as the duo won for the second straight time at No. 2 doubles, beating **Derek Fredrickson** and **Brad Thomas** 8-2 ... **Jian Long Zheng** picked up his second individual win of the season, topping Westminster's Fredrickson, 6-3, 6-1, at No. 2 singles.



Thomas More Saints (2-8, 2-5 PAC)



Thomas More fell, 6-3 to Bethany in its lone match last week ... Junior **Andrew Hetzer** and senior **Evan Bryan** combined picked up the Saints' three points in the match as they won at No. 1 doubles and Hetzer won at No. 1 singles and Bryan won at No. 2 singles respectively ... For the season, Hetzer is a combined 11-9 at No. 1 singles and doubles as he is 6-4 in singles and 5-5 in doubles.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (0-8, 0-6 PAC)



The Presidents dropped their only match of the week at Thiel (9-0) ... Freshman **Christopher Fadil** was the only W&J player to win a set as he fell 3-6, 6-0, 10-6 to Thiel No. 1 single **Louie Rubin** ... W&J closes its regular-season schedule on Tuesday versus Saint Vincent at 3:00 pm before preparing for the weekend's PAC Championship Tournament.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-5, 3-2 PAC)



It didn't take long for the Jackets to shake off the rust as all three doubles teams jumped on Thiel to take a 3-0 lead while giving up just two games ... The dominance continued in the singles as Waynesburg won five of the six matches ...
