Bethany finished fourth at the PAC championships, held at Grove City ... The #1 doubles tandem of **Dominic Costa** and **Patrick Greene** won the PAC crown with a 6-3, 6-0 triumph over the Waynesburg's team of Pamepinto/Kaluza ... Costa reached the finals at #1 singles but lost in straight sets in the final ... Reaching the consolation matches were Green (#2 singles), **Eric Beeson** (#3 singles), **John Joyce** (#4 singles) and the team of Joyce and **Toby Swango** (#3 doubles) but all were handed setbacks in their matches.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Junior Matt Yokitis and sophomore Ehren Frey claimed individual PAC singles championships this past weekend ... Yokitis defeated GCC's Phil Springirth, the No. 2 flight's top seed, 6-3, 6-3, while Frey edged Grove City's Geoff Gehring, 6-3, 6-3, to win the No. 4 singles title ... Senior Francis Burt was second at No. 2 singles, junior Jordan Genis placed second at No. 3 singles, and junior Shahin Nemazee also finished second at No. 6 singles ... Junior Matt Dubow placed third at No. 1 singles ... In doubles, the team of Dubow/Frey lost in the title match to Grove City, 6-3, 6-3 ... Burt and Nemazee also placed second at No. 3 doubles, falling to Gehring and Light of GCC in the finals 2-6 6-3 6-2

PAC MEN'S TENNIS NOTES

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines captured their 12th consecutive PAC championship title on Saturday, edging runner-up W&J by five points in the final team standings, 43-38

... Sophomore **Patrick Donahue** earned his second straight PAC most valuable player award by winning the championship at first singles, 6-2, 6-2 over Bethany's **Dominic Costa** ... Donahue also won first place at second doubles, teaming with freshman **Phil Springirth** to post a 6-3, 6-3 victory over W&J's **Matt Dubow** and **Ehren Frey** ... Thirty-year head coach **Joe Walters**, who has secured his 26th winning season at the helm (11-6), was voted PAC Coach of the Year.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesurg opened the week with a 5-3 home loss to Frostburg State ... The Jackets then place third at the PAC Championships over the weekend ... Leading the way for the Jackets was **Mark Gates**, who captured the #5 singles title with a three-set win over **Francis Burt** of Washington & Jefferson.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men's tennis team dropped to 0-9 on the season this week with losses to Div. II Slippery Rock and PAC rival Waynesburg ... Thiel will host two PAC schools this week, W&J and Bethany, before participating in the conference tournament.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's tennis team split a pair of non-conference contests to close the 2002 season, sweeping Hiram 9-0 on Tuesday before falling to Mount Union 7-2 on Wednesday ... With 10 wins this season, the Titan netters posted their most wins in a season since 1985 (11-4) ... Three Titan netters posted double wins against the Terriors: senior Chuck Correll captured #1 singles and teamed with sophomore John Libert at #1 doubles ... Also, freshmen Mark Gross and Corey Sacca won at #3 and #4 singles, respectively, while teaming for victory at #2 doubles ... The lone winners against Mount Union were Correll at #1 singles and the Gross/Sacca team at #2 doubles.
