Mummert, Floyd named PAC SAAC Scholar-Athletes of the Month for May, 2011

WEXFORD, Pa. – The Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) announced today that **Chelsea Mummert (York, Pa./Central York H.S.)** of Chatham University and **David Floyd (Irwin, Pa./Penn-Trafford H.S.)** of Waynesburg University have been named Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) Scholar-Athletes of the Month for May 2011.

Mummert is a senior student-athlete at Chatham and a member of the women's swimming & diving team. She is the two-time, back-to-back PAC Champion in the 100 backstroke. Mummert broke two individual school records this year at the PAC meet — the 200 IM record and the 200 backstroke record. She is the first person in Chatham's history to win a PAC individual title and currently holds seven Chatham swimming team records. Mummert has also been selected to the PAC Swimming & Diving All-Conference Team.

Out of the pool, Mummert is a psychology major and minors in biology and professional writing. She holds a 3.98 cumulative grade point average (GPA) and has been a member of the PAC Athletic Honor Roll. Mummert is also involved in several volunteer activities, as she has worked for The Children's Institute in 2009 and 2010 and the Ahead Program as a mentor from Fall 2008 to the present. Mummert has worked at a nursing home, volunteered with Toys for Tots, and raised money for the Women's Shelter of Greater Pittsburgh.

Floyd is a junior student-athlete at Waynesburg and a member of the men's soccer and men's tennis teams. He is a three-year starter on the men's soccer team and two-time honorable mention All-PAC soccer player. Despite joining the men's tennis team late in the season, Floyd finished second at sixth singles at the PAC championships following upset wins over the number-two and number-three seeds to earn All-PAC honors. He also placed third at sixth doubles at the championships. Floyd is a three-time member of the PAC Academic Honor Roll.

In the classroom, Floyd is a journalism major and holds a 3.93 cumulative GPA. He has served in multiple editorial staff positions with *The Yellow Jacket*, Waynesburg's campus newspaper. Floyd is also very active as a sportscaster and on-air talent with WCYJ-FM, Waynesburg's campus radio station, and has served in similar roles with WCTV, Waynesburg's campus television station. He is also a Student Ambassador at Waynesburg and is involved with multiple other clubs and organizations on campus.

Each month, SAAC members at a PAC school nominate a student-athlete to highlight based on academic and athletic accomplishments. Honorees must be a varsity member in their respective sport(s) and in their junior or senior year. Scholar-Athletes of the Month must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and be actively involved on his or her campus community.

Founded in 1955, the Presidents' Athletic Conference continues its mission of promoting intercollegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence. Consisting of 10 select private institutions in Pennsylvania, West Virginia, and Kentucky, the PAC remains a unique organization in this day of high pressure intercollegiate athletics. With academics at the center of each member's philosophy, the PAC is built on the principle that an athletic program is a part of college life, but not an entity in itself. The PAC annually crowns champions in 19 sports (10 men, nine women).
