## **Dolsak, Potter Named PAC SAAC Scholar-Athletes of the Month for September 2010**

WEXFORD, Pa. - The Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) announced today that **Emily Dolsak (McDonald, OH/McDonald)** of Westminster and **Cory Potter (Akron, OH/Green)** of Bethany have been named Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) Scholar-Athletes of the Month for September 2010.

Dolsak is a two-year letter winner in both track & field and basketball at Westminster. The junior is a two-time PAC champion in the discus throw as a member of the Titan PAC championship track & field team. For basketball, she was third on the team in scoring and second in rebounding as a freshman and improved to second on the team in scoring and first in rebounding her sophomore year. She was the Westminster SAAC WESPY "Two-Sport Female Athlete of the Year" as a freshman and sophomore.

Around campus, Dolsak is a mathematics major who has earned a 3.938 grade point average (GPA). She is an active volunteer in SAAC and varsity sports team community service activities. Dolsak is a member of Kappa Mu Epsilon (math honor society) and volunteers in the Westminster Learning Center, tutoring in math, economics, and accounting.

Potter is in his third year as a starter on the offensive line of the Bethany football team. Last year, he started all 10 games up front and helped Bethany rank second in the PAC in fewest sacks allowed with 16, which helped him earn Second Team All-PAC honors. This season, he has started the first two games at center for the Bison and helped them churn out 387 rushing yards in a 31-29 victory at King's on Sept. 11 in the PAC-MAC Challenge. So far in 2010, the Bison are ranked second in the PAC with 239.5 rushing yards per game.

Off the gridiron, Cory is an English major with a 3.3 GPA. He has participated in Bethany's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) All-Campus Clean-Up each of the last two years.

Each month, SAAC members at a PAC school nominate a student-athlete to highlight based on academic and athletic accomplishments. Honorees must be a varsity member in their respective sport(s) and in their junior or senior year. Scholar-Athletes of the Month must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and be actively involved on his or her campus community.

Founded in 1955, the Presidents' Athletic Conference continues its mission of promoting inter-collegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence. Consisting of 10 select private institutions in Pennsylvania, West Virginia and Kentucky, the PAC remains a unique organization in this day of high pressure intercollegiate athletics. With academics at the center of each member's philosophy, the PAC is built on the principle that an athletic program is a part of college life, but not an entity in itself. The PAC annually crowns champions in 19 sports (10 men, nine women).
