"PAC Sports Network" to Produce 12-Date Basketball Video Webcast Schedule in 2011-12

PITTSBURGH, Pa. – The "PAC Sports Network" will broadcast a 12-date schedule of Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) basketball doubleheaders and single games in 2011-12. The network, consisting of Western Pennsylvania broadcasters **Randy Gore**, **Justin Pyles** and **David Singer**, will produce live video webcasts covering all 10 PAC members during the upcoming conference basketball season, beginning with a doubleheader featuring Thomas More at Geneva on Wednesday, Nov. 30, 2011. "We are very excited to begin this new relationship with the PAC Sports Network, as we believe this will augment our current campus webcasting efforts while also helping us to reach new audiences," said PAC Executive Director **Joe Onderko**. "While we are beginning with basketball coverage this season, if successful we will consider branching into coverage of additional sports within the PAC. I look forward to working with our broadcast team to bring our fans even more great coverage of PAC basketball this year."

"The PAC Sports Network is honored to work alongside the Presidents' Athletic Conference and its member schools. With the great athletes and teams that the PAC boasts, we are excited to cover college basketball doubleheader action every week via our webstream," said Pyles. "Along with our live game webstream, we will offer coach and player interviews, highlights, and features. Additionally, our broadcasts will be archived and accessible via smart phone, allowing games to be viewed anytime and anywhere. We're looking forward to bringing PAC basketball to fans across the country."

Founded in 1955, the Presidents' Athletic Conference continues its mission of promoting intercollegiate athletics and the pursuit of academic excellence. Consisting of 10 select private institutions in Pennsylvania, West Virginia, and Kentucky, the PAC remains a unique organization in this day of high pressure intercollegiate athletics. With academics at the center of each member's philosophy, the PAC is built on the principle that an athletic program is a part of college life, but not an entity in itself. The PAC annually crowns champions in 19 sports (10 men, nine women) as a member of NCAA Division III.
