Bethany Bison

The Bison finished the Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD) Tournament with a 4-0 record after defeating Wesleyan (Ga.) 13-0 on March 8, and Lake Forest on the ninth, 3-2 ... Bethany then played in the prestigious NFCA Leadoff Classic on March 12-14 and went 1-4 ... The Bison defeated 14th-ranked Ithaca, 7-4, and fell to Coe (2-1), Illinois Wesleyan (8-0), Capital (13-4) and Muhlenberg (8-2) ... Jacki White and Leslie Lopez each collected two hits and two RBI's, while Angie DeSantis threw a complete game, allowing four runs on eight hits, and striking out seven in seven innings in the win ... The Bison will compete in the East Coast College Classic on March 19 and 20, with three games on the 19th.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened its season with a pair of losses at Juniata on Saturday ... The Eagles, who have won six of their first seven games, took game one, 11-1, in five innings and then earned a 4-1 decision in game two ... Senior P Lauren Pieri took the loss in game one as she allowed five earned runs in 1 2/3 innings of work ... Juniata plated five runs in the first inning and three more in the second en route to the victory ... W&J managed just four hits in the loss ... In game two, the Eagles broke open a 1-1 tie with three runs in the bottom of the fifth ... Freshman SS Stacey Bugle drove in both President runs in the doubleheader, while freshman CF Katie Orient picked up three hits and scored two runs ... Senior P Erin Galluze gave up two earned runs.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opens the 2004 season next Monday, March 22, at Allegheny ... The Wolverines open the season with three road doubleheaders, then play six consecutive twinbills at home ... Grove City returns six starters from last year's team that earned third place in the PAC, including all-conference picks Allison Atwood and Rachel Romance.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg posted a 2-8 record at the Rebel Games in Kissimmee, Fla. ... The Jackets split doubleheaders on Saturday and Tuesday and were swept in twinbills on Sunday, Wednesday, and Thursday ... In a 3-2 win over Illinois College Saturday, freshmen Kristen Hemingway went 4-for-4 and drove in the winning run in the bottom of the seventh inning with a walk-off double ... Hemingway led the team in hits in four of the 10 games. In addition to the four-hit game, she had three two-hit games during the week ... Junior P Shana D'Aurora went 2-3 during the week with a combined 10 strikeouts and six walks ... In Waynesburg's 13-4 win over Swarthmore, freshman Nicole McDonough went 2-for-4 with a double and triple.
