A 4-1 win in game one was the 500th of head coach **Jan Forsty**'s career, making her just the 10th Division III coach in history to reach that milestone ... The win was the result of a four-run outburst in the 6th inning, which erased a 1-0 deficit ... P **Angie DeSantis**, whose error in the top of the sixth helped the Lions score their run, made amends by slapping a two-run single in the bottom of the frame ... BC tacked on insurance runs on RBI singles by RF **Niki Zalaznik** and CF **Emily Patton** ... Bethany collected nine hits in the win, including three from Patton and two from DeSantis, who also went the distance in the circle for the win.
