5-8 Junior Catcher

Schafer led the Bison to a 2-3 record at the Roanoke/Bridgewater Tournament in Virginia last week, hitting .312 (5-of-16) with five RBIs and three runs scored. She started the Bison scoring parade in a 10-3 over the College of New Jersey with a two-run home run in the first inning.

PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 2-3 at the Roanoke Tournament, recording a big win over the College of New Jersey before suffering losses to nationally-ranked Roanoke and Emory ... Bethany opened the Tournament with a 5-3 loss to Averett before recording a 5-3 victory over Mary Washington ... In the CNJ win, CF **Destiny Clarke** went 3-4 and C **Amy Schafer** was 2-5 with a two-run homer in the first inning and three RBIs on the day ... The Bison defense faltered in the two losses on Saturday, committing nine errors, including six in the Emory loss ... Bethany trailed against Emory 6-5 with two outs in the seventh, but DH **Raquel Burns** tied the game with a solo home run before the Bison fell in eight.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J concluded its trip to Orlando, Fla., with an 0-8 record ... The Presidents were led by freshman C **Jill Shields**, who posted a team-high .400 batting average (6-for-15) in her first eight contests ... She also scored two runs and drove in another ... Freshman RF **Natalie Varacallo** also batted .333 in Florida, picking up four hits in 12 plate appearances ... The Presidents were hurt by errors during the road trip, committing a total of 36 miscues ... Senior P **Amanda Yaszak** made four appearances in Florida and holds a team-low 2.89 ERA.

Grove City Wolverines

At Geneva, the Lady Wolverines surrendered three unearned runs in the first game and three home runs in the night-cap as the Golden Tornadoes earned a 5-1, 6-0 sweep ... Senior P **Laura LeVake** scattered five hits in four innings, striking out two and walking none ... LeVake surrendered just two earned runs after Geneva jumped out to a 3-0 lead with three unearned runs in the second ... LeVake accounted for two of Grove City's four hits in Game Two, while sophomore P **Allison Atwood** allowed just five hits in four innings of work ... The Lady Wolverines committed just two errors in the twin bill.
