The Bison went 3-1 last week, sweeping a double-header at Wooster Saturday after a split with Marietta at home Tuesday. **Romney Waters** went 2-0 during the week with two complete games ... In 14 innings, she allowed zero earned runs and nine hits, while striking out six and walking one ... **Angie DeSantis** also had a dominating performance against Wooster Saturday, going the distance and allowing zero earned runs and five hits, striking out five and walking one in a 1-0 win ... **Janice Masters** hit .333 for the week, including a home run against Marietta in the 7-1 win Tuesday ... In game two against Wooster, **Heather Bainey** hit a two-run home run in the top of the seventh inning to give the Bison a 2-1 lead.

Washington & Jefferson surpassed its entire win total from a year ago in Myrtle Beach in the season's first trip by posting a 6-4 record ... Freshman DH **Jacklyn Rapaport** led the team with a .500 batting average in South Carolina (13-for-26) ... She hit one home run and drove in a team-high 14 runs ... She also posted a .692 slugging percentage ... Freshman SS **Stacey Bugle** also batted .410 with one homer and 12 RBI ... Freshman CF **Katie Orient** batted .400 out of the lead-off spot and held a .467 on-base percentage ... Senior **Lauren Pieri** led the W&J pitchers with a 2-1 record in South Carolina and a 2.91 ERA.
