Thiel College Junior Pitcher Brackenridge, Pa./Highlands H.S.

Troyan pitched both ends of a doubleheader sweep of Hiram (5-1 and 4-3) in Thiel's only action last week. She fired a two-hitter with five strikeouts in game one, then added a pair of strikeouts in game two.

Also nominated was senior P Rachael Schafer of Bethany, sophomore SS/C Rachel Romance of Grove City, junior 1B Angela ladanza of Washington & Jefferson, freshman OF Tina Ramer of Waynesburg, and senior SS Laura Raible of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

In their only action of the week, Bethany split a twinbill with Muskingum ... P Rachael Schafer continued her domination of the Lady Muskies in the opener, pitching a two-hit shutout whiles striking out six and walking one ... It was the fifth consecutive victory for Schafer over Muskingum, whom Bethany beat four times last year on their way to the Division III World Series ... A two-out RBI single by RF Leslie Lopez in the sixth provided the only run of the game ... In the nightcap, the hosts scored unearned runs in the third and sixth frames to spoil a solid pitching effort by Romney Waters ... Bethany managed only four singles in the game in getting shut out for the second time this season.

Washington & Jefferson earned its first victory of the year by defeating Seton Hill, 3-2, in the second half of a doubleheader in Greensburg on Tuesday ... The win marked the first in the career of Head Coach Stephani Ehrenfeld ... Freshman shortstop Chelsey Gillen broke open a 1-1 fifth-inning tie by scoring on a wild pitch and junior designated hitter Lauren Merkt singled home freshman leftfielder Jayann Freidhoff for the game-winning run ... Junior hurler Eric Galluze was awarded the win after allowing two earned runs on five hits ... Sophomore second baseman Larissa Lazar went 2-for-4 with one RBI in the game one loss ... Junior first baseman Angela ladanza led W&J in the doubleheader loss at LaRoche on Wednensday with two hits and one RBI.

Waynesburg christened its new home field with dominating wins in a doubleheader with Chatham on Monday, before two wins over Pitt-Greensburg Thursday and two losses at Denison on Saturday

... Tina Ramer and Haylee Swinchock blasted home runs against Chatham, while Swinchock's pair of two-run taters helped her go 5 for 5 for the day ... Ramer's homer, the first at the new park, was a grand slam in the first inning of game one ... Swinchock would homer in her second at-bat of the inning, before finishing the game 3 for 3, including a homer and two singles ... She hit another two-run homer in game two ...
