Bethany played in six games last week, including their first PAC action of the season ... After a pair of losses at Capital, the Bison split a twinbill at Geneva ... **Heather Immesberger** twirled a six-hit shutout while striking out five and C

Heather Henthorn, 3B Jill Wright and LF Elexis Riggle had RBIs in the 3-0 victory ... The shutout was the second of the year for Immesberger and the third of her career ... BC then fell in both ends of a doubleheader to Westminster Saturday ... Henthorn, Riggle and 2B Jamie Petrel all had two hits in game one, but the Bison couldn't capitalize in an 8-1 loss ... SS Ashley Marinacci then banged out two hits in the nightcap, but BC suffered a 7-0 defeat.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened the northern portion of the schedule with a single game at Saint Vincent as rain postponed the nightcap ... **Abby Greiner** belted a three-run homer in the 11-9 loss while **Kristy Bogusz** added a bases-

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats lost five of six games last week and fell to 6-12 overall ... They also dropped to 0-2 in the PAC with a pair of losses to Thomas More on Saturday ... Thomas More won the first game 6-2 before running away with Game 2, 13-2, in five innings ... 1B **Taylor Radeff** led the

Tomcats at plate with a .364 batting average (4-of-11) ... Also, SS/LF **Amber Cree** batted .308 (4-of-13) with three runs scored ... Freshman P **Elise Moore** earned her fourth win of the season in Thiel's 7-4 victory over Carlow University.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More opened Presidents' Athletic Conference action with a sweep of Thiel, 6-2 and 13-2 respectively ... Senior **Kim Kreimer** went 7-for-8 with

three triples, five runs and three RBI in the doubleheader sweep ... For the week, Kreimer hit 9-for-15 (.600) with three triples, six runs and four RBI ... Junior **Michelle Farler** was 2-for-2 with a homer as Thomas More swept Capital in non-conference action ... She added a complete game two-hitter with three strikeouts ... **Jamie Wisenall** was 2-0 with 10 strikeouts in 12 innings of work.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

After having doubleheaders vs. La Roche and Juniata postponed due to rain, W&J opened PAC play on Saturday with a sweep of Grove City ... Sophomore P **Rebecca Nachreiner** highlighted the game one win with her first career no-hitter (5 innings) ... She allowed one unearned run and fanned five ... Junior C **Hannah Schulz** clubbed

a grand slam, while junior RF **Ally Stasik** collected three hits and drove in four runs ... Schulz posted two hits and two RBI in the game two win ... Sophomore 1B **Valerie Schultz** also went 3-for-3 and scored two runs ... Freshman P **Georgia Schumacher** earned the win after allowing two runs on 12 hits ... W&J led 3-1 on Sunday, but JCU rallied for three runs in the bottom of the sixth ... Junior CF **Amanda Howard** homered to lead the Presidents' lineup.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg struggled in its first action since returning from Florida, losing both games of a doubleheader at Geneva ... The Golden Tornado hurlers limited the Yellow Jackets to one run in the two games and four total

hits in 40 at-bats (.100) ... 3B **Monica Miller** collected two of Waynesburg's four hits, while LF **Haley Kramer** registered the only RBI of the doubleheader ... Geneva torched the Yellow Jackets pitchers for 26 hits, including six doubles in 9.1 innings.



Westminster Titans

Westminster went 5-1 in six days last week, including a doubleheader sweep (8-1 and 7-0) of Bethany giving the Titans a 2-0 PAC record ... Westminster also swept a doubleheader at Penn State-Altoona Monday (2-1 and 11-1) and split a doubleheader at Penn State-Behrend Thursday (winning 5-1 and losing 1-0) ... The games were the team's first since returning from its spring break trip March 11 ... The Titans' leading hitters for the week were sophomore 3B **Amy Cornicelli** and senior P **Jennifer Pancake** ... Cornicelli batted .474

(9-for-19) with four RBIs and Pancake .471 (8-for-17) with 11 RBIs ... Pancake hit four home runs during the week, including three during the sweep of Altoona ... She also compiled a 3-0 pitching record with a 1.0 ERA in 21 innings of action with no walks.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

Sophomore **Mollie Stock** tossed a three-hitter and drove in all three runs with a bases-loaded triple in the win over Ursuline ... SVC hit three home runs (Stock, **Rachel Komarinski** and **Shannon Ballantyne**) in the win over Grove City ... Komarinski and **Terri Bundridge** are leading

the team with a .333 BA, while **Jostalyn Klosky** is hitting .313 ... Stock has yet to give up an earned run in nine innings pitched.
