CF **Emily Patton** and C **Colleen Kelly** both went 4-for-5, and drove in three runs ... It was the first four-hit game of Patton's career and second this season for Kelly ... 3B **Heather Henthorn** went 3-for-3 and scored four times ... Game two saw **Romney Waters** throw a complete game and also drive in two with a single in the sixth in a 5-3 win.
