PAC SOFTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER **Janice Masters** Bethany College Senior 3B Lansing, Ohio/ Bellaire St. John's H.S.

PITCHER Jennifer Pancake Westminster College Freshman Boardman, Ohio/ Boardman H.S.

Masters hit .455 (5-of-11) with two doubles, four runs and seven RBIs for the Bison last week, as Bethany went 3-1 with a split against nationally-ranked Muskingum and a PAC sweep of Grove City.

Pancake was 2-0 including her first career no-hitter, a five-inning, 12-0 win at Penn State-Altoona, while also earning the win in a nine-inning, 4-3 win over Allegheny. For the week, she allowed three runs (none earned) on seven hits with two walks and 18 K's in 14.0 innings.

Bethany Bison

The Bison went 3-1 last week, including a sweep at Grove City to start the PAC portion of the schedule ... The Bison won by scores of 7-1 and 11-3 ... Janice Masters led the way at the plate, hitting .455 (5-of-11) for the week, along with two doubles, four runs and seven runs batted in ... Romney Waters went 2-0 during the week, defeating Muskingum on Monday and Grove City in game one on Saturday against Grove City ... Both were complete game victories, and she allowed 11 hits and four runs in 14 innings, while striking out nine and walking none ... Emily Patton hit .429 (6-of-14) for the week, with three runs, while Heather Bainey hit .385 (5-of-13) with five runs scored.
