The lone run came in when C **Bridgette Fauth**, who went 3-for-3 in the game, hit a two-out RBI single in the first At Thomas More, Immesberger raised her record to 6-3 by holding the Saints to one run on four hits in a 3-1 triumph ... 1B **Nikki Gillis** had a two-run double to give Bethany the lead and SS **Ashley Marinacci** bashed her first career homer for an insurance run.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva was 3-3 last week ... After splitting a doubleheader with Bethany and dropping a pair of two-run decisions at Thomas More, Geneva

unloaded against Thiel by outscoring the Tomcats 19-0 in a doubleheader sweep ... **Ashley Archer** was 2-1 in the circle, while freshman **Rebekah Wahl** allowed just two earned runs in three appearances ...
