PAC SOFTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER LAUREN BORIS Westminster College Senior OF Gibsonia, Pa./ North Allegheny H.S. PITCHER ROMNEY WATERS Bethany College Junior Burgettstown, Pa./ Burgettstown H.S.

Boris hit .450 (9-of-20) while leading the Lady Titans to a perfect 6-0 week. She posted six runs scored and three RBIs.

Waters earned her second PAC honor of the season after posting a 2-0 mark for the Bison last week, allowing just one earned run in 15 innings for an 0.60 ERA while walking none and striking out 16 batters.

Bethany Bison

The Bison opened defense of their 2004 PAC regular-season and tournament championships by shutting out Grove City twice Wednesday (7-0, 12-0) and splitting another conference tilt with Washington & Jefferson Saturday (4-3 win in 8 innings, 12-5 loss) ... 2004 PAC Co-Pitcher of the Year **Romney Waters** earned two wins from the mound this week to improve to 9-3 on the season ... Senior **Heather Bainey** overtook **Emily Patton** for the team lead in hits this week as Bainey went 9-of-16 with three doubles in the pair of conference doubleheaders.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J posted a 1-3 record last week as it was swept by La Roche before splitting a PAC twinbill with Bethany ... Freshman P Kelsey Donahue took the game one loss versus La Roche after giving up five runs (four earned) on eight hits in 2 1/3 innings ... Sophomore SS Stacey Bugle went 3-for-4 with a run scored, while freshman CF Amanda Howard had a pair of hits ... Sophomore Courtney Grubich went 5 2/3 innings to earn the win for the Presidents in game two against the Bison ... Freshman 3B Melissa Metcalf led the lineup with two hits and four RBI, while freshman C Stephanie Spisak went 2for-5, including a two-run homer, and finished with three RBI ... Freshman LF Nataly Valeriano picked up two singles and a double in four plate appearances.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City earned its first PAC victory of 2005 at Waynesburg Saturday ... Rachel Romance's two-run triple in the bottom of the fifth gave Grove City a 5-3 lead ... Lauren Carlson earned the win in relief of starter Jes Flick ... Paula Rice also tripled in the victory while Abby Moose singled twice ... In the opener, Grove City pounded out 12 hits but left 12 runners on base, including eight through the first three innings ... Rice, Romance, Steph Briggs, Kelly Cozad and Carlson all had two hits ... Briggs cracked her second career triple in the fifth ... At Bethany Wednesday, the Bison limited Grove City to just three total hits on the afternoon ... Briggs broke up a Bethany no-hit bid in the opener.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College softball team posted a 3-1 record this week after failing to play a game in over two weeks due to numerous cancellations and postponements ... The Yellow Jackets started conference play on Saturday when it split a doubleheader against Grove City, managing a 3-2 victory in the first game before falling 5-3 in the second half of the PAC doubleheader ... Senior pitcher Shana D 'Aurora posted a 2-1 record and 2.25 ERA during two starts and a relief appearance (16 total innings) with 12 strikeouts this week ... Freshman Melissa Cashell led the Jacket offense with a .429 average (6 of 14) with six RBI and also scored four runs in the four games.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped both ends of a double header against Case Western Reserve Saturday at Fuller Park, losing 3-0 and 4-3 ... Senior SP Anita Deloe was saddled with the game one loss after allowing three runs on six hits with five walks ... Thiel tied game two at 1-1 in the bottom of the first on an RBI groundout from senior 3B Kimmie Leathers ... Case regained the lead in the third before the Tomcats picked up a pair of runs in the fourth on RBI singles from Leathers and senior CF Julie Deloe ... A pair of RBI singles by Case proved to be enough to secure the game two win ... Leathers paced Thiel offensively in game two, finishing 2-for-3 with a pair of RBIs and a run scored.

Westminster Titans

Westminster swept six games last week, giving the Lady Titans wins in 13 of their last 14 contests ... Sophomore P Jennifer Pancake won all three of her starts with an 0.67 ERA and 15 strikeouts ... Junior Kat Parfitt was 2-0 in the circle, while classmate Courtney Snyder was 1-0 with a pair of saves ... Senior OF Lauren Boris led the way at the plate, hitting .450 (9-of-20) for the week with six runs scored and three RBIs ... Senior 1B Heidi Kimmel was 3-for-4 with a double and three RBIs in a 12-6 win at Penn State-Altoona ... Pancake, freshman 3B Hannah Parker and junior C MaryAlice Skinner each posted RBI singles in a 4-0 shutout at Pitt-Bradford ... The Lady Titans open PAC play at Grove City Tuesday.
