PAC SOFTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER Heidi Kimmel Westminster College Junior 1B Poland, Ohio/ Poland Seminary H.S.

Kimmel hit .600 (6-for-10) with two doubles, four runs scored and four RBIs last week, leading the Lady Titans to a 4-0 record with doubleheader sweepf of Case Western Reserve and Penn State-Behrend

Waters went 3-0 in the circle with complete game wins over Waynesburg and York and a relief win in a 4-3 extrainning win over the Jackets. For the week, she allowed no earned runs on eight hits with one walk and 16 strikeouts in 15 2/3 innings of work.

Bethany Bison

The Bison went 3-1 last week and remained undefeated in the PAC (4-0) with a sweep of Waynesburg on Tuesday (1-0 and 4-3) ... Bethany also split a doubleheader at York the next day, dropping game one, 7-6, and winning the second game 3-1 ... P Romney Waters racked up all three Bison wins, throwing complete games against York and Waynesburg, and also picking up another win against Waynesburg by pitching the final 1.2 innings in a game-two comefrom-behind 4-3 victory ... At the plate, Heather Bainey hit .429 (6-for-14) to lead the squad in hits, while also knocking in two runs and scoring four times ... Janice Masters and Colleen Kelly also drove in two runs during the week.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson was held to nine combined hits in a doubleheader loss to Point Park on Monday ... Senior 1B Angela ladanza led W&J with a 3-for-4 day at the plate in game one and senior P Lauren Pieri was a tough luck loser after allowing two unearned runs on six hits ... Senior SP Erin Galluze went all seven innings in game two and gave up six runs (three earned) on six hits ... ladanza singled home freshman OF Jayann Freidhoff with the game-winning run in the seventh against Waynesburg in game one on Wednesday ... Pieri allowed one run on five hits in the win ... Sophomores RF Melissa Witzberger and C Jill Shields both had run-scoring singles in game two ... Galluze tossed seven innings of threehit ball and fanned three Yellow Jackets.

PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City evened its PAC mark at 2-2 Tuesday by taking two games from Thiel ... Freshman pitcher Lauren Carlson earned her first career win in the nightcap, tossing a four-hitter ... She also went 2-for-3 at the plate, scoring once ... Classmate Kristy Bogusz went 2-for-3 in both games, including a double in the opener ... Senior Allison Atwood tossed a complete game in the opener, allowing no earned runs ... Jes Flick roped a pair of hits to help spark the Grove City offense ... Grove City's 3-2 start is the program's best since 1998, when the Wolverines opened 10-3 ... That was Grove City's last winning season as well as the Wolverines' most recent PAC title team.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg's 0-4 record could easily have been 4-0 after the Jackets lost four road PAC games all by one run and held opponents to a combined nine runs in the four games ... Leading up to the losses at Bethany on April 6, the Jackets went 26 days without playing a game ... The Jackets broke up a one-hitter by Bethany P Romney Waters with two hits and no outs in the seventh inning of a 1-0 loss, but failed to score ... Waynesburg came back from a 3-0 deficit to send the second game of the twinbill to extra innings, but again stranded a runner in scoring position to end the game ... The Jackets also suffered a pair of 2-1 losses at W&J on April 7 when the Jackets offense suffered by combining for just eight hits in the two games.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats opened their 2003 PAC schedule last week with a pair of tight losses at Grove City, losing 3-2 and 2-1 ... Senior P Jen Troyan suffered her eighth loss of the season in the opening game, throwing a complete game and allowing three runs on nine hits with six strikeouts ... Freshman DP Meggan Malik went 2-for-3 at the plate with an RBI and a stolen base ... Freshman P Megan Viebranz fell to 1-3 with the game two loss after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on eight hits with a pair of strikeouts ... Viebranz helped out her own cause with an RBI double in the third inning and a sacrifice fly ... Sophomore OF Katie Walker, junior 2B Tina Cale and sophomore 1B Jen Stiveson each hits.

Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans have won 11 of their last 12 after home DH sweeps of Case Western Reserve (4-0 and 5-1) and Penn State-Behrend (5-4 and 8-0) last week ... Freshman P Jennifer Pancake allowed her first earned run of the season in the 5-4 win over Behrend, breaking a streak of 73 1/ 3 innings without an earned run to start her collegiate career ... Sophomore OF Karisa Nilsen belted a two-run homer in the 5-4 win over PS-B ... Sophomore P Katie Parfitt fired a three-hitter in the 8-0 win for her first career shutout ... Freshman P Tracy Tonkavitch gave up one run on five hits with three strikeouts in the 5-1 win over CWRU ... Junior 1B Heidi Kimmel leads the team at the plate with a .380 average.
