STRONG ARMED: Thiel LHP **Kristen Moreland** has been virtually unhittable in PAC play this season, holding conference opponents to an overall batting average of .153 in 20 innings of work ... Geneva's **Julie DiLorenzo** put on a show Saturday as the hurler posted back-to-back shutouts against Westminster; she has won 11 of Geneva's 12 victories this season ... Geneva Golden Tornadoes (12-12)

Saint Vincent Bearcats (9-11)
