PAC SOFTBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

RACHAEL SCHAFER

Bethany College Senior Pitcher/Designated Hitter Pittsburgh, Pa./Perry H.S.

Schafer went 3-0 in the circle last week, including a pair of shutouts, as bethany went 6-0 to run its win streak to 10 games. In 20 innings pitched, she allowed just one unearned run and 10 hits while striking out nin and walking four. At the plate, four of her five hits went for extra bases, including a home run, a triple and two doubles.

Also nominated was junior IF/P **Allison Atwood** of Grove City, senior C **Tami Hassell** of Thiel, freshman OF **Jayann Freidhoff** of Washington & Jefferson, senior OF Kerri Petko of Waynesburg, and junior 3B **Julie Zappa** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison ran their win streak to 10 games and put themselves in the driver's seat for the top seed in the PAC Tournament with a 6-0 week ... C Amy Schafer had a two-run double and P Rachael Schafer tossed a three-hitter as BC topped W&J 3-0 in the opener ... 3B Janice Masters and SS Heather Bainey each had two hits and two RBIs in the second game as the Bison posed a 9-1 triumph ... Against York, the Bison outscored the Spartans 20-0 and outhit them 26-8 in the sweep ... The Westminster wins were highlighted by Bainey and RF Leslie Lopez each having two hits and an RBI in the opener, while Masters and Rachael Schafer mashed homers and P Romney Waters tossed a two-hitter.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J concluded last week with one win in four PAC contests, dropping a doubleheader to Bethany and splitting with Waynesburg ... Three Bison pitchers combined to allow just nine hits and one run in the sweep on Tuesday ... Junior P Lauren Pieri took the loss in game one despite limiting Bethany to two earned runs on four hits ... BC broke open a scoreless tie in game two with six runs in the fourth ... Junior P Erin Galluze allowed two earned runs on 11 hits, while sophomore C Jill Shields added two singles ... Freshman RF Jayann Freidhoff led the Presidents in the game two victory over Waynesburg on Thursday by going 3-for-3 with two RBI ... W&J scored all eight runs in the third, highlighted by three two-run doubles.

PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City fell out of first place in the conference with a 1-3 mark in PAC play last week ... Junior Allison Atwood picked up both victories for Grove City, fanning 25 batters in 21 innings ... She has 76 K's in 65 innings this year ... Senior CF Ellie Smith batted .500 during the week while sophomore OF Abigail Russell started all six games and hit .308 during the week ... Freshman P-DH Jes Flick belted a pair of triples last week ... She also drove in three runs in a 6-4 win over Pitt-Bradford Saturday night ... In both victories during the week, Grove City fell behind 1-0 early before rallying in the fourth inning ... Grove City closes conference play this week with doubleheaders against W&J and Bethany.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg went 3-1 this week, improving to 3-3 in the PAC ... The Jackets' defense held opponents to 24 scoreless innings in the four games, despite giving up all 16 runs during the week in three innings, including eight third-inning runs in an 8-3 loss to W&J Thursday ... The loss gave Waynesburg a doubleheader split with W&J after the Jackets won the first game 6-4 led by Kari Mariner's two doubles and two runs scored ... Sarah Langsdorf pitched the complete game for Waynesburg, as she struck out seven and walked three giving up six hits ... Langsdorf also pitched a complete-game four-hitter in Waynesburg's 4-0 win over Thiel Saturday, as she improved to 6-4 ... Waynesburg wound up sweeping Thiel after a 9-4 win in the second game.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel split doubleheaders with Case Western Reserve (L 4-8, W 7-5) and Grove City (L 1-3, W 10-0 (5)) before being swept by Waynesburg (L 0-4, L 4-9) on Saturday ... Senior C Tami Hassell led the way in the split at CWRU, going 4for-4 with a home run and a triple ... Junior 2B Amanda Swanson managed to get two of the Tomcats' four hits in the opening game loss to Grove City to go along with a pair of stolen bases ... Junior Jen Troyan allowed just two hits while striking out a pair of batters in five innings in their 10-0 game two win ... Sophomore LF Sheri Timko and freshman RF Megan Sanetski each drove in three runs ... Sophomore SS Tina Cale went 2-for-3 with a double in the game two loss.

Westminster Titans

Westminster was 2-4 last week, with a 2-2 mark against PAC competition ... The Lady Titans opened the week by sweeping Grove City 2-0 and 6-5 (in eight innings) on Tuesday, but dropped doubleheaders to NAIA Geneva (3-0 and 7-5) on Thursday and PAC leader Bethany (3-1 and 6-0) on Saturday ... Senior P Darcy Sutton recorded her third shutout of the year in the GCC opener, firing a threehitter with six strikeouts ... In game two, WC overcame a 5-1 Lady Wolverine advantage to win in eight innings ... Junior 3B Julie Zappa was 3-for-4 with a double in the come-from-behind win ... Junior OF Rachel Lawrence was 2-for-3 with a double in the first Geneva game ... Freshman 2B Abby Mazar was 2-for-3 with two runs scored in game two.
