REBECCA NACHREINER Wash. & Jeff. Junior Pittsburgh, Pa. North Hills H.S.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City is 2-6 in league play after dropping a pair of PAC doubleheaders last week ... The Wolverines swept Penn State-Greater Allegheny Thursday in the first meeting between the teams

... In the opener, freshman Lauren Pennell threw a five-inning no-hitter ... It is Grove City's first no-hitter since Laura LeVake threw one against Peace on March 1, 2002 ... In the nightcap, Pennell went 3-for-4 with a double and four RBIs ... C Abby Greiner went 4-for-4 with a double and three RBIs ... Greiner went 10-for-17 (.588) during the week.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats went 1-3 last week, splitting a doubleheader with Bethany Thursday before being swept by Thomas More Saturday ... Against the Bison, **Kerstin Makowski** and **Mollie Stock**

Junior **Jamie Wisenall** allowed four earned runs in 14 innings of action

The Presidents had won five consecutive games before dropping the final game of the Geneva doubleheader Saturday ... W&J swept Chatham in Pittsburgh behind junior 1B **Valerie Schultz**'s six hits, five runs and four RBI ... Schultz batted .615

during the week and scored five runs ... Senior CF Amanda Howard also batted .615 during the week with three runs scored ... W&J batted .315 as a team and three pitchers limited opponents to a .222 batting average ... Junior P Rebecca Nachreiner appeared held teams to one run in 13 2/3 innings over three games ... Freshman **Lis Schulz** fired a complete-game, two-hit shutout in the Titans' 10-0 win over GCC.
