PAC SOFTBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Hassell earned PAC Player of the Week honors after batting .636 (14-of-22) with two doubles, two triples and seven runs scored last week, as she led the Tomcats to a 3-3 record. She currently is tied for the team lead in batting average (.400) and leads the squad with five triples this season.

Also nominated was sophomore pitcher **Nicole Serene** of Bethany, sophomore pitcher/second baseman **Allison Atwood** of Grove City, and freshman catcher **Jill Shields** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany ran its winning streak to six games with a sweep at Westminster ... In the opener, RF **Leslie Lopez** went 4-4 with an RBI, stolen base and two runs as the Bison took the lead with two runs in the fourth and held on for a 4-3 victory ... P **Rachael Schafer** threw a complete game, allowing three runs on five hits while striking out seven ... In the nightcap, **Nicole Serene** blanked the Lady Titans on four hits in a 1-0 triumph ... DH **Raquel Burns** singled in the game's only run in the first inning and Serene and a solid Bison defense did the rest ... Bethany will now get ready for six PAC games this week as the three-time Conference champs go for the top seed and hosting rights for the 2002 Tournament.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J picked up its first win of the season on Monday in a doubleheader split with Waynesburg ... The Presidents then swept a DH from Grove City on Thursday to claim its third victory in four games ... Sophomore P **Lauren Pieri** led the Presidents to their first win of the year by allowing just three hits and two walks in the complete-game shutout against the Yellow Jackets ... She also fanned a season-high 10 batters ... In the sweep of Grove City, Pieri and sophomore P **Erin Galluze** combined to allow just two earned runs in 14 innings ... Pieri allowed two runs on nine hits in picking up her second-straight win in game one. She did not walk a batter and struck out four.

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines dropped both ends of its first conference DH, surrendering six unearned runs to host W&J ... In the first game, the top third of the Lady Wolverine batting order went a combined 7-for-12 at the plate, but W&J jumped out to a 5-0 lead after three innings and held on to win by a five-run margin ... RHP **Allison Atwood** collected three hits in four at-bats, while CF **Ellie Smith** and RF **Stephanie Briggs** each went 2-for-4 ... Briggs banged out her third double in four games with a two-run shot to left center in the fifth ... In the nightcap, RHP **Laura LeVake** struck out eight and yielded five runs (two earned) on four hits. Grove City was held to six hits with Atwood accounting for one to finish 4-for-8 in the twin bill.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg split a PAC pair with Washington & Jefferson last week, falling 1-0 and winning 5-2 ... The Bethany College DH was rained out Saturday.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 3-3 last week after starting the week off right with a doubleheader sweep of Penn State Behrend, taking the first game 4-2 and the second 3-2 ... Sophomore shortstop **Tina McCune** paced the Tomcats in the PSB series, going 4-for-6 with a triple and two RBI and two stolen bases ... In the squads' split with the Terriers, junior catcher **Tammi Hassell** finished 6-for-8 with four runs scored and an RBI ... Senior pitcher **Melissa Mosco** leads the team with a 10-5 record and a 2.10 ERA ... Hassell has started all 22 games for head coach **JoAnn Gordon** this season and is averaging .400, tied for the team lead with McCune.
