The Titans also split a non-conference twinbill against Case Western Reserve Friday, winning 2-0 and losing 13-4 ... Senior P Jennifer Pancake batted .588 (10-for-17) with two doubles, a home run, and eight RBI and freshman P Jennifer Emery batted .563 (9-for-16) with five doubles, a home run, and eight RBI to lead the Titans during the week ... Pancake did not give up an earned

run in 26.2 innings of work as she posted a 4-0 record during the week, giving up one run on 13 hits with one walk and 13 strikeouts. ... Sophomore Amy Cornicelli ended the week as she hit a walkoff, RBI single in Saturday's second game at Saint Vincent.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets snapped their six-game losing streak in the first half of Tuesday's doubleheader with a win against Saint Vincent ... Waynesburg won the first game 2-1, recording four hits before dropping the

nightcap, 5-2, managing just two runs on eight hits against the Bearcats ... Sophomore Autumn Minor earned the victory for Waynesburg, tossing a complete game, three-hitter, allowing just three runs, while fanning five and walking two ... In its victory, Waynesburg plated runs off an RBI double by SS Suzi Joyce and a fourth-inning, RBI single by 2B Katie Slaughter ... In game two, the Yellow Jackets took a 2-0 lead in the first behind an RBI double from Joyce, who later scored on a throwing error.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats went 1-3 against PAC competition last week, splitting a doubleheader against Waynesburg (lost 2-1, won 5-2) before dropping a pair of contests Saturday to visiting Westminster (6-1 and 5-4) ... Junior Jostalyn Klosky hit her first career HR in the second

game against Westminster ... She is batting .300 on the year, third on the team behind Lesa Bauer (.381) and Mollie Stock (.325) ... Stock is leading the pitching staff with a 3-1 record and an ERA of 0.89 ... Bauer recorded 10 strikeouts against Westminster, and has struck out 36 in 39 innings this year.
