Bethany Bison

The Bison had 2-1 leads on W&J in the sixth innings of both games Tuesday but fell victim to late President rallies in dropping both ends of the doubleheader ... In the first game, an RBI single by **Colleen Kelly** and run-scoring double

by **Kara O'Dell** in the fourth gave BC a 2-1 lead ... The Presidents would push two across in the sixth and an unearned insurance run in the seventh to post the 4-2 win ... In game two, O'Dell launched a solo homer in the first and had an RBI double in the fifth to give the Bison another 2-1 lead ... However, a two-out error in the sixth opened the door for the Presidents to score four runs and take a 5-2 lead ... O'Dell blasted a two-run homer in the seventh but Bethany's rally fell short ... O'Dell finished the twinbill 5-for-7 with two homers.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped both ends of a home nonconference doubleheader to Lake Erie Monday before suffering a pair of PAC losses at Waynesburg Tuesday ... Against Waynesburg in game one the Tomcats held a 3-1 lead before the Yellow Jackets responded with three runs in

the bottom of the seventh to post the 4-3 win ... Freshman 3B **Katie Maul** and sophomore C **Amy McCluskey** drilled RBI singles Maul finished 2-for-3 in game one ... Waynesburg plated four runs in the third inning of game two and tacked on eight more in the sixth en route to the 12-0 shutout....Senior 1B **Jen Stiveson** finished 2-for-3 for the Tomcats.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson earned its first sweep of Bethany since 1996 after posting 4-2 and 5-4 victories on Tuesday at Bethany Field ... Freshman P **Rebecca Nachreiner** led the sweep by notching the win in game one and then the save in the nightcap ... She allowed two runs on five hits, while fanning five Bison in game one and

nailed down the save in game two by retiring the final three hitters ... Sophomore P **Kelsey Donahue** notched the victory in game two after pitching six innings and allowing four runs on eight hits ... Sophomores DH **Tanesha Minney** and CF **Amanda Howard** and freshmen 1B **Valerie Schultz** and RF **Kelly Morrow** all had two hits for the Presidents ... Schultz also scored a pair of runs.

Thomas More rattled off three more regional wins, going 3-1 for the week ... Two single-season records fell this

week as junior **Kim Kreimer** broke the school doubles record with her 15th of the year and sophomore **Jamie Wisenall** set a new strikeout mark (78, passing the old mark of 72) ... Junior **Sommer Case** drove in six runs for the week, including a key grand slam that helped TMC to the 7-5 win over Transylvania ... Snoke boasted a 0.33 ERA (one earned run) for the week and tossed three complete games ... 1B Melissa Schrecengost led the offense with a .455 batting average (10-for-22) and five RBI, while SS Haley Kramer (9-for-22) batted .409 with five runs scored and three steals ...
