Bainey led the Bison to an 8-0 week (4-0 in the PAC) by hitting .565 (13-of-23) with four home runs, nine runs scored, four stolen bases and 11 RBIs.

Waters won her second straight PAC honor (and third of the season) after going 4-0 on the week. She has not allowed an earned run in her past 25 1/3 innings. For the week, she walked five and struck out 33 in 27 innings, including an 8-0 no-hitter against PAC rival Thiel.

PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison have won eight straight and 11 out of their last 12 to improve to 20-9 on the year ... Pitchers Romney Waters and Angie DeSantis have combined to limit opponents to only 14 runs during the last eight contests ... Waters, who has won her past six starts, hasn't allowed an earned run in her last 25.1 innings and has shut down opponents completely from scoring in her last 13 innings ... DeSantis has won four straight decisions and sliced her ERA 1.5 runs ... Offensively, the Bison have more than doubled their home-run output by posting six in the last eight outings (10 total for the year) and scored better than 1/3 of their offensive output during the streak by hammering out 57 runs over their last eight games.

W&J split two non-conference doubleheaders and swept Case Western Reserve last week ... Freshman P Kelsey **Donahue** went all seven innings to pick up the win in game two versus Allegheny Wednesday ... She allowed two unearned runs on seven hits, while fanning five ... Freshman CF Amanda Howard led the Presidents with two hits and two RBI, while freshman C Stephanie Spisak had a solo homer ... Sophomore SS Stacey Bugle led the Presidents in game one at CWRU as she went 3-for-4. including two triples, with three RBI ... Sophomore P Caryn Becker earned the win after allowing four hits in five innings ... Howard was 4-for-5 in the game two win with two RBI ... Becker scattered five hits in a complete-game shutout of JCU.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City split two PAC doubleheaders last week against Westminster and Thiel ... Against Westminster, Kelly Cozad scored the first game's lone run on a wild pitch in the third inning ... Junior Sarah Smith earned the shutout victory ... At Thiel Thursday, the Wolverines trailed 6-0 in the opener but eventually pulled to within 7-5 and had the tying run at second base in the seventh ... Kristy Bogusz belted a bases-clearing triple to key the rally ... In the second game, Bogusz drove in four more runs as the Wolverines rallied from an early 4-0 hole ... Paula Rice doubled twice while Rachel Romance drove in three runs with a bases-loaded double.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg split a pair of PAC doubleheaders this week losing to Bethany (1-0, 8-7) before defeating Westminster (2-0, 1-0) ... On Saturday, senior P Shana D'Aurora recorded both of the wins after tossing a four-hit shutout in game one and pitching 4.1 innings in the second game, which was decided in the 10th inning by the international tiebreaker ... Freshman 2B Melissa Cashell drove in both runs of game one with a double in the fifth inning ... In the tiebreaker inning of game two, Waynesburg pinch ran Katie Slaughter to start the inning ... Slaughter later scored on an errant throw by the Titans to give the Yellow Jackets a 1-0 advantage ... In the bottom half of the frame, D'Aurora retired each of the three Westminster batters she faced.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel posted a 2-4 record last week, earning splits with Geneva and Grove City before being swept at Bethany Saturday... Freshman P Mindy Moyer had a no-hitter through six against Geneva before surrendering a solo home run in the top of the seventh...Moyer finished with a complete game two-hitter, allowing three runs with six walks and eight strikeouts ... She helped out her own cause with a two-run single ... In the gwin over Grove City, junior 1B Jen Stiveson went 3-for-4 with three RBIs ... Freshman LF Leah Snyder was a perfect 4-for-4 with three runs scored and an RBI while junior DP Katie Walker finished 2-for-4 with a pair of RBIs and a run scored ... Senior Anita Deloe earned the win on the mound.

Westminster Titans

Westminster split six games last week, but was just 1-3 in PAC play ... All three PAC losses came by shutout ... Freshman 3B Hannah Parker was 2-for-2 with a double in a 1-0 loss at Grove City ... Freshman SS Maria Joseph was 2-for-2 with a double and three RBIs in an 8-2 win at GCC ... Westminster scored in the final at bat in both games to sweep La Roche 3-2 and 8-7 ... Parker belted a oneout double, then scored on an error to break a 2-2 tie in the opener ... Game two saw junior 2B Abby Mazar rip an RBI single in the bottom of the 10th to plate the game-winning run ... Junior P Courtney Snyder took the loss in game two at Waynesburg despite throwing 4 2/ 3 innings of hitless relief, as the Jackets scored on an error in the 10th.
