Atwood earned the win in both ends of a PAC dobuleheader against Waynesburg on Friday. She fired a nine-inning 1-0 shutout in the opener, allowing just two hits and taking a no-hitter into the eighth. In game two, she earned the win in relief in a 4-3 GCC victory to improve to 4-1.

# PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

## **Bethany Bison**

The Bison went 3-1 last week and remained in first place in the PAC with a sweep of W&J, followed by a split with Thiel ... The Bison defeated W&J by scores of 3-1 and 10-5, then defeated Thiel in game one on Saturday 8-0 in five innings before falling in the nightcap, 4-3 ... Senior 3B Janice Masters hit .500 (6for-12) for the week, with three runs, a home run and five RBI ... In game one against W&J, she went 2-for-3 with a home run and a run and two RBI ... She also went 2-for-3 in game one against Thiel, with a double, two RBI and one run ... Emily Patton hit .417 (5-for-12) for the week with a team-high five runs and three RBI ... Romney Waters went 2-0 last week with a 1.12 ERA.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents dropped seven out of eight contests last week, including five of six conference matchups ... Senior P Lauren Pieri took the loss in game one at Bethany on Thursday after giving up three runs on six hits in six innings ... Freshman SS Stacey Bugle was 3-for-3 with three runs in game two, while sophomore 3B Chelsey Gillen had two hits and two RBI ... Freshman P Caryn Becker tossed a complete game eight-hitter in the 4-2 victory at Thiel on Friday ... Gillen had two hits, while junior C Jill Shields scored two runs ... Gillen continued her hot streak with a career-high four hits in the loss to the Tomcats in game two ... Freshman OF Courtney Grubich was 3for-3 on Saturday versus Westminster.

# **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City ran its win streak to four Friday with a pair of one-run wins over Waynesburg ... Sophomore Jes Flick cracked game-winning singles in both ends of the doubleheader to give Grove City its first four-game win streak since 1999 ... Flick went 4-for-4 with a triple in the second game ... She also pitched in the second game, hurling five innings and allowing one run ... Senior Allison Atwood earned the win in both games ... In the opener, Atwood pitched seven no-hit innings before settling for a 9-inning, two-hit shutout ... In the second game, Atwood recorded the final two outs in relief of Lauren Carlson d ... Sophomore Alicia Stefanak went 2-for-3 in the first game.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After its 1-0 upset win over Westminster on Sunday, Waynesburg has played eight consecutive one-run games in which it posted a 1-7 record ... The Jackets win over the Titans also broke an 11-game losing streak ... Senior P Sarah Langsdorf earned her first win of the season, improving to 1-9 despite an ERA of 0.56 in her last two starts and 1.24 ERA in PAC play ... Langsdorf struck out 12 in a 1-0 loss to Grove City on Friday ... Kristen Hemingway knocked in the game-winning run over the Titans with a first-inning RBI single scoring Sheena Morgan ... Waynesburg's offense struggled during the week, however; the team combined for 15 hits in four games (1-3) led by Nicole January and Amanda Stanley with three apiece.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 2-4 in PAC action ... Thiel dropped a pair at Westminster Thursday (3-5, 1-2) before picking up splits against W&J (2-4, 4-3 (10)) Friday and Bethany (0-8(5), 4-3) Saturday ... The Tomcats needed 10 innings to pick up the 4-3 win over W&J ... Junior C Anita Deloe's RBI double in the bottom of the 10th scored sophomore OF Katie Walker to give Thiel its first PAC win of the season ... Senior P Jen Troyan went the full 10.0 innings, allowing three runs (2 earned) on 11 hits ... Walker finished 4-of-5 with a double, three steals and two RBIs ... After suffering an 8-0 loss in game one. Thiel bounced back to hand the Bison a 4-3 defeat, their first PAC loss of the year.

#### Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans went 5-2 last week ... After falling 8-4 at Mount Union, WC posted DH sweeps of Thiel (5-3 and 2-1) and W&J (6-4 and 10-3) before splitting with Waynesburg (1-0 loss, 3-2 win) ... Sophomore P Katie Parfitt won all three of her starts for the week and improved to 5-1 on the season ... Freshman P Jennifer Pancake went 2-2 and is now 13-4 on the campaign ... In the W&J doubleheader, junior 1B Heidi Kimmel was a combined 5-for-7 with a home run, four runs scored and two RBIs ... Pancake, who homered in the second W&J game, leads the squad with a .438 batting average ... The Lady Titans can clinch the top seed and home field advantage in the PAC Tournament with DH wins over Grove City and Bethany this week.
