The Bison broke out the sticks in a big way Sunday, as they mashed 7 home runs in taking two from Case Western 15-4 and 16-14 ... C **Bridgette Fauth** had 2 HR's and 6 RBIs in opener and 1B **Stephanie Shafer's** 2-run HR in 6th gave Bison 16-14 win in game 2.
