

### Thomas More Saints

Thomas More closed a span of eight games in four days with a 7-1 mark ... Junior **Michelle Farler** threw a no-hit-

ter as the Saints knocked off Bethany 11-0 ... Junior **Jamie Wisenall** was great in the circle all week, going 5-0 with a 1.42 ERA and 32 strikeouts ... She took a no-hitter into the final inning of the opener with Saint Vincent before allowing two hits and an unearned run ... In the second GCC contest, Wisenall stroked her first hit of the season – a two-run home run that snapped a 5-5 tie ... Senior **Kim Kreimer** hit .556 for the week, with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI and 10 runs scored ... Senior **Sommer Case**, who missed the previous four games due to injury, stroked a home run in her first at bat and hit .556 with two doubles, six RBI and 10 runs scored.

# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg won its first game of the week in convincing fashion, 8-0, before ending the weekend with three straight losses ... In the win against Carlow, seven starters collected a hit with four players posting multi-hit games

... Sophomore P **Autumn Minor** earned the victory, allowing just two hits in the complete-game shutout with no walks and five strikeouts ... The Celtics answered back with a 9-8 victory despite a 3-for-5 game from 2B **Melissa Cashell** and a three-run homer by SS **Suzi Joyce** ... On Saturday, Westminster swept a doubleheader with Waynesburg, surrendering a combined one run and six hits in two games.

# Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats had a busy week, posting a 3-4 overall record - 2-3 against current PAC members, while splitting a doubleheadewr with incoming PAC foe Geneva ... Junior **Jostalyn Klosky** hit her first career HR in the second game against Westminster ... She is batting .300

on the year, third on the team behind **Lesa Bauer** (.381) and **Mollie Stock** (.325) ... Stock is leading the pitching staff with a 3-1 record and an ERA of 0.89 ... Bauer recorded 10 strikeouts against Westminster, and has struck out 36 in 39 innings this year.
