Bethany Bison

Bethany went 3-3 last week, including two wins over Thiel and a split at Thomas More ... CF **Emily Patton** had two hits and three RBIs and 3B **Heather Henthorn** was a perfect 3-for-3 in a 13-2 game one victory over Thiel ... In the 9-0

game two win, **Kara O'Dell** was 3-for-4 with two doubles and four RBIs and **Heather Immesberger** blanked the Tomcats on three hits ... BC then dropped a pair to PAC-leading Waynesburg Thursday ... At Thomas More on Saturday, Bethany took game one, as **Angie DeSantis** scattered six hits for her first shutout of the season and O'Dell blasted a three-run homer to account for all the runs in a 3-0 triumph ... In the nightcap, Bethany took a 3-0 lead but the Saints rallied for a 5-3 win ... Patton had two hits in the loss.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel was 0-6 last week in PAC contests, falling in doubleheaders against Bethany, Westminster and Thomas More ... Bethany posted wins of 13-2 and 9-0 in Greenville on Monday while Westminster claimed victories of 12-0 and 9-0 on Wednesday ... After getting rained out on

Friday, the Tomcats traveled to Thomas More on Sunday and lost 10-2 and 9-0.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson won three of five PAC games this past week and leads Grove City, 3-0, in the bottom of the first inning in a game suspended by rain ... In the 8-2 win over Waynesburg, sophomore CF Amanda Howard went 4-for-4 and scored three runs, while freshman P Rebecca Nachreiner limited the Yellow Jackets

to two unearned runs on five hits ... Nachreiner held Grove City to only three hits on Friday and struck out five ... Nachreiner and sophomore 2B **Stephanie Spisak** both had two hits and one RBI ... Junior SS **Stacey Bugle** and sophomore LF **Ally Stasik** recorded RBI singles in the 10th inning on Saturday to help W&J defeat Westminster in game two.



Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans ran their win streak to eight games with a sweep of Thiel (12-0, 9-0) and a 4-0 shutout of Washington & Jefferson before having the streak snapped with a 3-1 loss to the Presidents in 10 innings ... Senior P **Jennifer Pancake** was 2-1 despite not allowing an earned run and striking out 11 in 17 innings, extending her streak of consecutive innings without an earned run to 36 2/3 ... A pair of Lady Titans posted strong weeks at the plate ... Senior 2B **Abby Mazar** hit .538 (7-of-13) with six runs scored and five RBIs, while

junior OF **Stephanie Cornicelli** batted .583 (7-of-12) with six runs scored and a pair of stolen bases ... Senior P **Kat Parfitt** fired a two-hitter with four strikeouts for her first win of the year at Thiel.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 1-2 in completed games last week ... The Wolverines earned a split in a non-conference doubleheader at Penn State-Behrend Wednesday ... Grove City fell in the opener, 1-0, but bounced back for a 3-2, 9-

inning win in the nightcap ... Freshman P Julia Coulombe earned the victory in game two with five innings of hitless relief ... Coulombe also singled in the eventual game-winning run in the win at Behrend ... Grove City tied the game in the seventh as junior CF Paula Rice singled in C Kristy Bogusz ... Grove City dropped the front end of a doubleheader at W&J Friday, 8-0 ... The second game was suspended in the first inning due to rain and lightning with Grove City trailing, 3-0 ... Grove City will host Thiel and Waynesburg this week.



Thomas More Saints

For the second straight week, the Saints – who are ranked eighth in the region – finished 3-1 ... After dropping

a heartbreaker to Bethany, TMC secured three straight wins ... Junior **Kim Kreimer** broke the school's single season hits mark of 53, set in 2003 ... She now has 57 hits on the season, 30 of which went for extra bases ... For the week, she had a .615 average (8-for-13) with six runs scored and five doubles ... Junior **Sommer Case** drove in a team-high six RBI while hitting .385 for the week ... Senior **Becky Horn** had four RBI ... Sophomore **Jamie Wisenall** dominated in the circle, hurling 9 1/3 innings and allowing just two hits, while going 2-0 ... She included a one-hit complete game shutout against Thiel.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Two of the three Yellow Jacket victories last week came on their final at-bat, starting with an 8-7 victory over W&J in game two Tuesday ... OF Amy Mills led off the bottom of the seventh by reaching on an error, as all seven Waynesburg batters in the seventh reached base ... Starting P Autumn Minor drove in the winning run with a

fielder's choice and finished the game with two RBI ... Minor pitched a complete-game shutout in game one of the doubleheader against Bethany ... 3B **Monica Miller** went 2-for-3 with a run scored and RBI, while C **Kristyn Klueg** collected a pair of hits ... In game two, Miller gave Waynesburg an early 1-0 lead before the Bison tied the game in top of the seventh, 1-1 ... The Jackets won the game on a one-out single by OF **Courtney DeFalco** that scored Mills.
