Fuqua led Geneva to the NCCAA East regional crown and a split against first place Westminster last week as the GTs posted a 5-1 record. Fuqua was 11-21 (.524) with eight runs scored and ten RBI. She had four doubles, a triple and a homer. For the season, Fuqua leads Geneva with 44 hits and 28 RBI.

DiLonardo picks up her second PAC Pitcher of the Week honor for 2012. She posted a 3-1 record last week in 28.2 innings of work. She allowed just two earned runs (0.49 ERA) and struck out 23 batters. In doing so, DiLonardo broke Geneva's all-time record for strikeouts with 498. She also became the first pitcher in school history to surpass the 200 strikeout mark for a single season.

Also nominated was freshman **Kiersten Conwell** of Bethany, junior **Lauren Clarke** of Grove City, sophomore **Ally Vrcek** of Saint Vincent, junior **Erin Shuman** of Wash. & Jeff., and sophomore **Carrie Maier** of Waynesburg.

HOME STRETCH: Grove City managed to take two games (7-4, 7-4) from previous PAC leader Westminster ... Geneva also took a game from Westminster by a score of 6-1 ... With those three losses, Westminster is now tied for first place with Saint Vincent, with both boasting a 10-4 PAC record ... Saint Vincent will travel to Westminster on April 24 for a key doubleheader.

NEWS AND NOTES: Christina Fuqua hit .600 (9-for-15) in Geneva's four NCCAA Regional games with seven runs scored and eight RBI ... Thomas More's **Sara Young** had a 0.70 earned run average in 10 innings pitched in three appearances last week ... Thiel's **Ashley Dolan** hit .571 (10-for-21) with 10 RBIs, four doubles and hit the first homerun of her career.

AROUND THE PAC: Grove City's **Lauren Clarke** went 2-0 with an 0.93 ERA last week ... Chatham's **Alex Miklos** went 3-for-3 in Chatham's 6-1 win over W&J ... **Carrie Maier** went 2-for-1 on the week with a 2.13 ERA throwing two complete game shutouts for Waynesburg ... Bethany's **Mindy Bierhals** hit .545 in four PAC games with three RBIs.

Bethany split two conference doubleheaders last week at Saint Vincent and at home against Waynesburg ... **Mindy Bierhals** was 3-for-3 with 2 RBI and **Kelsey Bish** threw a complete game in BC's 8-1 win at Saint Vincent in game one ... Bierhals and **Emily Jump** both had two hits and one RBI in game two, but a two-run homer in the eighth gave SVC a 3-2 victory ... After Bethany was held to two hits in an 8-0 setback to Waynesburg Sunday, the Bison took game two behind a sterling effort from **Kiersten Conwell** ... She fired a five-hit shutout, her second of the season, to lift the Bison to a 2-0 triumph ... Jump and **Liz Kletzli** drove in one run each in the victory and **Maria Vallone** was 2-for-4.

Chatham Cougars (9-21, 1-13 PAC)



Chatham won the first matchup of a split with Washington & Jefferson for their first conference win ... With nine victories this season Chatham has tied its record for wins in the season ... **Alex Miklos** led the team going 3-for-3 at the plate, scoring two runs and recording one RBI ... Pitcher **Anne Marie Brnardic** allowed four hits and struck out four ... In the game two loss, **Laurel Homa** went 2-for-2, while **Robin Greenberg** and **Ashley Lamb** each recorded one hit ... In the 6-2 loss to Thiel College, **Elizabeth Deckelman** tripled in the seventh inning to score Miklos for the Cougars' second run ... Both went 2-for-4 at the plate ... Miklos and **Natalie Vazquez** both accounted for the two hits in the 11-2 loss against Thiel.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (23-15, 7-5 PAC)



Geneva's softball team won the NCCAA East regional crown by sweeping a four-game series against Houghton ... The GT's outscored the Highlanders 34-4 in the four-game set ... **Christina Fuqua** led the offensive charge in the regional by going 9-for-15 in the four games with seven runs scored and eight RBI ... Geneva got back into PAC play by splitting a doubleheader with first place Westminster ... After dropping game one 3-1, the GT's rallied back for a 6-1 victory in the night cap ... **Julie DiLonardo** finished her week with a 0.49 ERA in 28.2 innings of work ... With 23 strikeouts last week, DiLonardo became Geneva's all-time strikeout leader with 498 career punch outs.

Grove City Wolverines (18-18, 6-8 PAC)



Grove City thrust itself back into conference tournament contention by going 3-1 in conference play last week ... Wednesday, Grove City picked up its first-ever win over Thomas More as the Wolverines won 4-0 ... **Lauren Clarke** fanned 11 in a shutout victory ... Friday, the Wolverines earned their first road conference sweep of the season by sweeping Westminster, 7-4 and 7-4 ... It marked Grove City's first sweep of the Titans since 1997 ... **Allison Rayburn** went 4-for-6 in the twinbill with a homer and two doubles ... **Faith Jentsch** earned the pitching win in Game One and Clarke nailed down the second game ... **Kelsey Shirey** went 3-for-3 in the opener and **Erica Gmuer** went 3-for-3 in Game Two.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (21-13, 10-4 PAC)



The Bearcats posted a 3-1 record this week against conference opponents Bethany and Thomas More ... In the game one loss against Bethany, **Shannon Baczek** and **Becky Deane** each recorded 2-3 performances on the day ... The Bearcats won game two with the help of a two run homerun off that bat of **Alyssa Grossman** in the top of the eighth innings ... Grossman finished the day going 3-for-4 with two RBI, one double, and one homerun ... **Ally Vrcek** went all eight allowing only two earned runs with 11 strikeouts ... The Bearcats traveled to Thomas More College where they swept the Saints by identical scores of 3-1 ... In game one, Baczek hit her first career homerun to break a 1-1 tie.

Massengill was 3-for-3 with three RBI, Dolan went 3-for-3 with two RBI and Masters was 2-for-2 with four RBI that included a homerun ... In the eight inning win over Oberlin, once again Massengill had a perfect day at the plate going 4-for-4 with five RBI that included a double, stolen base and homerun ... **Molly Jo Everett** was 3-for-4 with two RBI and Masters went 2-for-4 with an RBI ... In the second win over Oberlin, Dolan went 3-for-4 with two RBI.

Thomas More Saints (21-15, 8-6 PAC)



Thomas More went 1-3 last week in PAC doubleheaders against Grove City and Saint Vincent ... The Saints had three players bat over .400 as **Brittany Wegman** batted .556 with a home run, two runs batted-in and two runs scored, **Alex Walter** batted .429 with a RBI and **Catie Luck** batted .400 with a double ... In the pitching circle, **Sara Young** had a 0.70 earned run average in 10 innings pitched in three appearances, while **Ronni Burns** had a 3.29 ERA in 17 innings pitched and struck out 16 ... For the season, Wegman leads the team at the plate with a .467 batting average as she is 43-of-92 with eight doubles, six home runs, 26 RBI and 25 runs scored and Burns leads the team with a 2.58 ERA.
