PAC SOFTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER STEPHANIE SPISAK Wash. & Jeff. College Freshman C Pittsburgh, Pa./ North Hills H.S. PITCHER JENNIFER PANCAKE Westminster College Sophomore Boardman, Ohio/ Boardman H.S.

Spisak led W&J to a PAC sweep of Waynesburg Wednesday by posting the game-winning hits in both contests. Her fifth inning RBI single gave W&J a 5-4 win in the opener, then a three-run double broke a scoreless tie and give the Presidents a 3-0 win in the nightcap. She was 4-of-6 (.667 avg.) with a run scored and four RBIs in the doubleheader - W&J's only action of the week.

Pancake was a perfect 3-0 in the circle with a 0.00 ERA in 16 innings for Westminster. She posted a one-hit, 2-1 win over Hiram and a three-hit 4-0 shutout (her seventh of the year) over Thiel, along with a relief win over Hiram. She allowed one unearned run on five hits with two walks and 14 strikeouts during the week for the 4-0 Lady Titans.

Bethany Bison

Bethany carried victories in 11-straight contests before falling to Capital 2-1 Thursday ... Victories included in that streak from the past week were a sweep of Case Western Reserve (4-0, 2-1) Monday and the first-game of the Capital doubleheader 4-2 ... Despite the loss, Bethany has posted wins in 14 of their previous 16 games ... The Bison have only one conference doubleheader left – a home tilt with Westminster – before their season comes to a conclusion this week.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J has won six of its last seven games after sweeping Waynesburg Wednesday ... Freshman C Stephanie Spisak had four hits, including both game winners, and four RBI in the road sweep ... Sophomore hurler Caryn Becker evened her record at 5-5 overall after allowing four runs on eight hits in the complete game ... Spisak led the lineup with three hits and one RBI, while freshman CF Amanda Howard was 2-for-3 with one run scored and one stolen base ... Spisak provided all the runs W&J would need in the bottom of the sixth of game two as she brought home freshman 1B Tanesha Minney and sophomores SS Stacey Bugle and RF Courtney Grubich with a double ... Sophomore Michelle Galluze (5-0) limited Waynesburg to three hits.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 0-4 last week as both Geneva and La Roche both swept the Wolverines ... Grove City struggled offensively last week, scoring just four runs and hitting .187 on the week ... Against Geneva Tuesday, Steph Briggs and Kristen Hughes had the Wolverines' two hits in a 3-0 Game One loss ... In the nightcap against Geneva, Paula Rice and Kristy Bogusz both cracked doubles ... Abby Moose had two hits and swiped a pair of bases in the opener at La Roche while Hughes tripled and Rachel Romance doubled in the nightcap ... Junior lefty Sarah Smith allowed just two earned runs in 17 innings last week ... As a team, Grove City posted a 1.59 ERA last week.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg posted a 10-2 victory in its first game of the week before suffering three straight losses, including two from W&J ... The Yellow Jackets spilt a nonconference pair with Allegheny Monday when they scored a season-best 10 runs in its 10-2 victory before dropping the nightcap 3-2 ... Waynesburg took a 9-0 lead with a six-run, six-hit second inning when it notched seven consecutive base runners, including 3B Monica Miller and OF Courtney DeFalco, who each hit tworun doubles ... DeFalco finished the game a perfect 3-3 at the plate with three RBI and a run scored ... Senior P Shana D'Aurora recorded her third win in three appearances in game one, while freshman P Dilanne Bedillion suffered the loss despite not allowing an earned run.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats suffered a doubleheader sweep at Westminster in their only contests of the week ... Senior SP **Anita Deloe** took the loss on the mound in both contests ... She went six innings and allowed four runs (1 earned) on three hits in game one and tossed a complete game in the nightcap, allowing seven runs (four earned) on eight hits ... Freshman C **Mindy Moyer**, junior 1B **Jen Stiveson** and junior LF **Katie Walker** each had hits for the Tomcats in game one ... Stiveson, sophomore RF **Meggan Malik** and freshman SS **Jessica Bombassaro** had RBIs in game two.

Westminster Titans

Westminster posted four wins last week with sweeps of Hiram (2-1, 4-2) and PAC rival Thiel (4-0, 7-3) ... Sophomore P Jennifer Pancake earned the win in both Hiram games ... She fired a one-hitter with one walk and six strikeouts while giving up one unearned run in the opener, then won game two in relief ... Senior 1B Heidi Kimmel posted a game-winning RBI double in the seventh inning of game one ... Junior 3B Karisa Nilsen and junior 2B Abby Mazar each went 2-for-3 in the nightcap ... Pancake improved to 16-3 with her seventh shutout of the year in the Thiel opener, while sophomore OF Kristin Zyskowski doubled and drove in a run ... Junior Kat Parfitt improved to 5-0 with the game two win, while Mazar was 3-for-4 with a double and five RBIs.
