PAC SOFTBALL 2010 - Week 8 Conference Notes

FINAL STRETCH: Thomas More is in the driver's seat for the top seed and hosting rights for the 2010 PAC Tournament heading into the last week of the season ... Spots 2 through 4 will be decided this week, as Westminster, Bethany, Thiel and Grove City all have a chance ... With its 19-15 overall record and four game still remaining in the season, Geneva's berth to the NCCAA national tournament still hangs in the balance ... They will have to finish the season at least at .500 to be considered for the trip.

SCHOOL RECORDS: In game two vs. W&J, Westminster's **Jennifer Emery** hit a three-run homer, the 19th home run of her career and the one that moved her into sole possession of the school record previously shared with **Jennifer Pancake** who had 18 from 2004-07 ... By recording its fifth save as a team last week, Grove City set a new school record for the most in a season ... Wolverine **Lauren Pennell** earned her third save last week in a game versus Penn State-Behrend, also setting a new record.

PAC SOFTBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (23-11, 5-3 PAC)



Bethany's week included a sweep at Chatham, a split at Westminster and its DH at Thiel getting rained out ... The Bisons' winning streak reached eight with their two wins over Chatham, as they pulled away for a 10-0 in the opener, which featured C **Liz Kletzli** driving in seven runs, and then they used a SF by 2B **Chelsea Butler** for the winning run in a 5-4 victory ... Kletzli had 9 RBIs in the twinbill and scored the winning run in the 2nd triumph, while **Emily Jump** threw a four-hit shutout in the first game and recorded the final 2 outs of the second for the save ... BC lost a 1-0 pitchers' duel in the first Westminster game, but recovered to pull out a 4-1 win in the 2nd game.

Chatham Cougars (7-22, 2-10 PAC)



Tiffani Jagielski pitched six innings with one strike out, two walks, five hits, and five runs against Bethany ... **Natalie Vazquez** and **Alexandra Miklos** each went 1-3 in the loss ... In the nightcap, Chatham scored four runs, but it was not enough to earn the victory and the Cougars fell again by a final score of 5-4 ... Against Grove City, **Julia Eck** tallied a total of three RBIs in the 8-4 loss ... Chatham tallied a total of 10 hits in the nightcap against the Wolverines – two from Vazquez, two from Miklos, three from Murgi, two from Eck, one from Petty, one from Taverna, and one from **Abby Brennan**.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (19-15)



Geneva was running on all cylinders with a six-game winning streak heading into a doubleheader at Saint Vincent on Saturday ... The Bearcats cooled off the GTs by handing them their first sweep since returning from Florida ... P **Julie DiLorenzo** saw her personal 11 game winning streak snapped in the circle as she fell to 17-8 on the season ... Geneva saw a seventh inning lead slip away in game one before falling 9-2 in the night cap ... The week started with four victories including sweeps over Grove City and Penn State Beaver ... **Adriane Blake** had seven RBI's in the sweep over Penn State and she ended the week with a team-best 41 RBI's on the year ...

Grove City Wolverines (12-19, 5-5 PAC)



Grove City continued its late season push towards a PAC tournament berth by closing the week on a four-game win streak ... Thursday, GCC earned a sweep of visiting Chatham, using a five-run third inning on its way to a 7-4 win in the opener ... The Wolverines then won the nightcap, 9-5 ... **Lauren Pennell** earned the win in both games ... Friday at PSU-Behrend, Pennell fired a four-hit shutout in a 1-0 game one win ... She then recorded her school-record third save in the nightcap as Grove City secured an 8-5 win ... DP **Leeza Covatto** went 3 for 4 in game two while **Amanda Sheppeck** doubled and singled ... Lauren Clarke picked up her sixth pitching win of the year.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (15-12)



The Bearcats enjoyed a strong week, going 5-1, sweeping doubleheaders with Pitt-Greensburg and Geneva and splitting with Thiel ... LHP **Shauna Hetrick** went 3-0 in the circle with one save, allowing just three earned runs and 13 hits while striking out 26 batters in 22 innings ... She struck out nine batters in her complete game victory over UPG on Monday, before whiffing 10 in her complete game, four-hitter against Geneva on Saturday ... Offensively, **Maria Adams** went 9-for-18 in six games, including a game-winning RBI double in the seventh in the Bearcats' 5-4 win over Geneva ... **Sam Shumaker**, went 7-for-18 on the week, with three doubles, five RBIs, and six runs.

Thiel Tomcats (15-13, 6-4 PAC)



Thiel split their Thursday doubleheader against the Saint Vincent Bearcats, picking up the victory in game one, 5-4, and dropping game two, 1-4 ... Junior C **Melissa Rankin** led the Tomcats offensively going 3-for-4 at the dish, tallying an RBI and a run scored, while **Ashley McLimans** and **Stephanie Smith** each notched a pair of hits and an RBI ... The Tomcats' Saturday game against Bethany was rained out and postponed until Thursday, April 29.

Thomas More Saints (18-14, 10-0 PAC)



The Saints went 4-0 last week as it swept a pair of PAC doubleheaders with Wash. & Jeff. and Waynesburg to remain undefeated in the PAC heading into the final week of the regular season ... In the first game of the doubleheader with W&J, P Dana Bors hurled a complete game no-hitter against the Presidents and 1B **Brittany Wegman** hit a home run to center field in the second inning for her seventh of the season and 20th of her career to set the new Thomas More softball career home run record ... For the week, Wegman batted .778 with one double, the home run, five runs batted-in and seven runs scored and Bors had a 2-0 record in the pitching circle with a 1.75 earned run average as she pitched 12 innings giving up four runs (three earned) on five hits and striking out six.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (11-21, 3-5 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson's hopes of earning a spot in next weekend's PAC Tournament were dashed this week after dropping four conference games ... The Presidents went without a hit in the first game versus Thomas More, but held the lead in both Saturday games versus Westminster before the Lady Titans rallied to win ... Sophomore 2B **Stephanie Zur** has come on strong for the W&J offense and batted .444 last week ... She scored three of W&J's six runs ... Junior 3B **Victoria Doerschner** had three runs batted in during the Westminster twinbill ... Senior LHP **Georgia Schumacher** suffered three losses on the mound, but notched 10 strikeouts.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (11-17, 4-8 PAC)



It was a tough week to swallow for the Waynesburg University softball team ... While the Yellow Jackets went 0-4 against the top two teams in the Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC), they led in two of the contests ... CF **Amber Pivik** had a big week for the Jackets ... The junior homered three times as part of a four-for-10 week (.400 batting average) and drove in four runs ... She also walked twice and boasted an impressive 1.300 slugging percentage ... She also recorded a .500 on-base percentage.

Westminster Titans (20-12, 7-3 PAC)
