#### BRITTANY WEGMAN Thomas More Sophomore 1B West Harrison, Ind. East Central H.S.

Wegman batted .778 as she was 7-for-9 with one double, a home



run, five runs batted-in, seven runs scored and was walked five times. In the Saints' game one win over W&J, she hit a home run to center field in the second inning for her seventh of the season and 20th of her career to set a new Thomas More softball career home run record.

#### PAC Pitcher of the Week

Schulz posted a 3-0 record in four appearances and three starts

last week. She logged a 0.31 ERA in 22.1 innings with just one earned run, 18 hits and two walks. Schulz posted 17 strikeouts, including seven in a 4-1 win over W&J in which she went seven innings and allowed one run on six hits with no walks.

#### PAC SOFTBALL 2010 - Week 8 Conference Notes

FINAL STRETCH: Thomas More is in the driver's seat for the top seed and hosting rights for the 2010 PAC Tournament heading into the last week of the season ... Spots 2 through 4 will be decided this week, as Westminster, Bethany, Thiel and Grove City all have a chance ... With its 19-15 overall record and four game still remaining in the season, Geneva's berth to the NCCAA national tournament still hangs in the balance ... They will have to finish the sesaon at least at .500 to be considered for the trip.

SCHOOL RECORDS: In game two vs. W&J, Westminster's Jennifer Emery hit a three-run homer, the 19th home run of her career and the one that moved her into sole possession of the school record previously shared with Jennifer Pancake who had 18 from 2004-07 ... By recording its fifth save as a team last week, Grove City set a new school record for the most in a season ... Wolverine Lauren Pennell earned her third save last week in a game versus Penn State-Behrend, also setting a new record.


#### Bethany Bison (23-11, 5-3 PAC)

with their two wins over Chatham, as they pulled away for a 10-0 in the opener, which featured C Liz Kletzli driving in seven runs, and then they used a SF by 2B Chelsea Butler for the winning run in a 5-4 victory ... Kletzli had 9 RBIs in the twinbill and scored the winning run in the 2nd triumph, while **Emily Jump** threw a four-hit shutout in the first game and recorded the final 2 outs of the second for the save ... BC lost a 1-0 pitchers' duel in the first Westminster game, but recovered to pull out a 4-1 win in the 2<sup>nd</sup> game.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats (15-12)

The Bearcats enjoyed a strong week, going 5-1, sweeping doubleheaders with Pitt-Greensburg and Geneva and splitting with Thiel ... LHP Shauna Hetrick went 3-0 in the circle with one save, allowing just three

earned runs and 13 hits while striking out 26 batters in 22 innings ... She struck out nine batters in her complete game victory over UPG on Monday, before whiffing 10 in her complete game, four-hitter against Geneva on Saturday ... Offensively, Maria Adams went 9-for-18 in six games, including a game-winning RBI double in the seventh in the Bearcats' 5-4 win over Geneva ... Sam Shumaker, went 7-for-18 on the week, with three doubles, five RBIs, and six runs.

#### Thomas More Saints (18-14, 10-0 PAC)

The Saints went 4-0 last week as it swept a pair of PAC doubleheaders with Wash. & Jeff. and Waynesburg to remain undefeated in the PAC heading into the final

week of the regular season ... In the first game of the doubleheader with W&J. P Dana Bors hurled a complete game no-hitter against the Presidents and 1B Brittany Wegman hit a home run to center field in the second inning for her seventh of the season and 20th of her career to set the new Thomas More softball career home run record ... For the week, Wegman batted .778 with one double, the home run, five runs batted-in and seven runs scored and Bors had a 2-0 record in the pitching circle with a 1.75 earned run average as she pitched 12 innings giving up four runs (three earned) on five hits and striking out six.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (11-17, 4-8 PAC)

It was a tough week to swallow for the Waynesburg University softball team ... While the Yellow Jackets went 0-4 against the top two teams in the Presi-

dents' Athletic Conference (PAC), they led in two of the contests ... CF Amber Pivik had a big week for the Jackets ... The junior homered three times as part of a four-for-10 week (.400 batting average) and drove in four runs ... She also walked twice and boasted an impressive 1.300 slugging percentage ... She also recorded a .500 on-base percentage.

#### Chatham Cougars (7-22, 2-10 PAC)

Tiffani Jagielski pitched six innings with one strike out, two walks, five hits, and five runs against Bethany ... Natalie

Grove City continued its late season push towards a PAC tournament berth by closing the week on a fourgame win streak ... Thursday, GCC earned a sweep of

visiting Chatham, using a five-run third inning on its way to a 7-4 win in the opener ... The Wolverines then won the nightcap, 9-5 ... Lauren Pennell earned the win in both games ... Friday at PSU-Behrend, Pennell fired a four-hit shutout in a 1-0 game one win ... She then recorded her school-record third save in the nightcap as Grove City secured an 8-5 win ... DP Leeza Covatto went 3 for 4 in game two while Amanda Sheppeck doubled and singled ... Lauren Clarke picked up her sixth pitching win of the year.
