Pennell batted .550

(11-for-20) with four doubles, eight runs scored and eight RBIs last week, leading the Wolverines to a perfect 6-0 record (4-0 vs. PAC opponents). She posted a .591 on-base percentage and .750 slugging percentage, while also going 3-0 in the circle.

Bethany went 4-4 last week, including an extrainning victory over PAC-leading W&J ... After losing game one 5-0, BC fell behind 2-0 in the night-

cap ... RBI doubles by **Ashley Marinacci** and **Andrea Thomas** tied the game in the fourth and the Bison picked up the win on a bases-loaded walk to Thomas in the eighth ... **Heather Immesberger** earned the win, her 13th of the season ... The senior hurler also recorded her 300th career strikeout in the Thiel twinbill ... The Tomcats won the opener on a walk-off homer, but BC earned the split in their final at-bat of game two when a Thiel error allowed the winning run to score ... Bethany swept Franciscan Sunday.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

After splitting a pair of games with Point Park, the Golden Tornadoes swept a doubleheader from Waynesburg University ... The Golden Tor-

nadoes are 25-13 for the season with one more week left in the regular season ... **Jackie Anthony** had a great week with a .733 average (11-for-15) ... Anthony had nine stolen bases and seven runs scored in four games ... **Rebekah Wahl** and **Ashley Archer** each have 12 victories on the season ... **Amy Pearce** needs just three RBIs to break the single season record, while she needs just five RBIs to set the career mark.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats went 3-3 on the week ... Tuesday, SVC swept Chatham ... In the opener, Rachel Komarinski went 3-4 with two doubles, while Mollie Stock and Courtney Buhl each doubled twice ...

Thomas More finished the regular season tied for first, but will be the second seed in the PAC tournament ... Freshman **Dana Bors**

went 2-1 with a 0.95 ERA, including 2-0 in PAC action, with 24 strikeouts to lead Thomas More ... Senior **Jamie Wisenall** had a ERA of 1.47 for the week Junior **Kaycee Bischoff** led the Saints, hitting .350 with four RBI



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets clinched a berth in the PAC Tournament last week with a sweep against Westminster last week ... Freshman 3B/P

Amanda Baughman belted her fourth homer of the season, posted five RBI and earned the victory in Game 2 against the Titans ... After being swept by Geneva, the Yellow Jackets closed the regular season with a split of one-run contests against Thomas More ... Waynesburg scored the game-winning run in the first game after an errant snap throw allowed junior C Kristyn Klueg to score ... Junior P Autumn Minor allowed just two hits and posted a careerhigh 10 strikeouts in the victory.



Chatham Cougars

The Chatham softball season came to a close after losing both games of a PAC doubleheader at Grove City College by scores of 8-3 and 17-1 ... Chatham

had a solid start to the season with an 8-8 record through 16 games ... The Cougars then struggled after pitcher **Katie Lloyd** was lost for the season due to injury and the team lost its final 18 contests ... Chatham was led throughout the season by its lone senior **Jennifer Quimby**, who finished with a .388 batting average and 17 runs batted in.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City continued its late-season surge by going 6-0 last week ... GCC wrapped up PAC play by sweeping Thiel and Chatham ... The Wolverines went just 1-11 in PAC play last year but

finished 2008 with a 6-8 league mark ... The team's seven-game win streak is the longest for the program since April 6-20, 2004 ... Grove City pitchers posted an 0.78 ERA and two shutouts last week ... Saturday, all nine GCC starters recorded hits as the Wolverines posted 21 hits in a 17-1 win over Chatham ... Christine Slater went 4-for-4 while Lauren Pennell added three hits ... Pennell threw a pair of shutouts last week.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel wrapped up its season on Saturday, splitting a doubleheader with Bethany ... The win over the Bison in game one was keyed by C **Britain Callen**'s

seventh inning walk-off three-run homer ... The win was Thiel's first over Bethany since the 2004 season ... The program's 11 wins are the most since posting 12 in 2004 and the five PAC victories are the most since registering a 5-9 mark in 2003.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson earned the top seed in this week's PAC Tournament despite dropping three of four games last week ... The Presidents will host the conference tournament for the first time in school history ... W&J can tie the school record for victo-

ries in a season with one in the PAC Tournament ... Senior CF **Amanda Howard**, who has started every game W&J has played over the past four years, led the Presidents with a .583 batting average last week ... Junior P **Rebecca Nachreiner** fired a complete-game, one-hit shutout in the Presidents' only victory last week ... She struck out five Bison during the 5-0 win.



Westminster Titans

Westminster went 2-4 last week including losses in both games of doubleheaders at Waynesburg (1-9, 4-6) Monday and at home vs. Thomas More (2-4, 2-3) Thursday before sweeping first-place

W&J (2-0, 6-2) on the road Saturday ... Sophomore Addie Parker led the Titans during the week by batting .350 (7-for-20), while freshman Lis Schulz was 5-for-15 with a home run and junior Amy Cornicelli was 5-for-17 ... Schulz and sophomore Jennifer Emery were the winning pitchers vs. W&J ... Emery finished the week with a 1.00 ERA and a 1-2 record after going 21 innings with 14 runs (3 earned) off 23 hits and two walks and four strikeouts.
