Bethany Bison

The Bison finished their season by dropping twinbills to Allegheny and Grove City, as six seniors saw their careers come to an end ... With five hits in the Grove City games, CF **Emily Patton** became the school's all-time hits leader

(183) ... She had already set the record for career at-bats (565) and finished second in runs scored (112) ... Romney Waters wrapped up her brilliant career as the third-winningest pitcher in BC history (52) ... She was also ranked second in K's (374) and shutouts (17), third in ERA (1.25) and starts (69) and fourth in complete games (55) ... P Angie DeSantis concluded her four years ranked fifth in K's (147) and starts (58)... It was also the final games for C/1B Colleen Kelly, 2B Sami Steele and OF/P Lindsay Cowser.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 0-5 last week, dropping three contests to PAC opponents ... After suffering a 15-7 game one loss at Grove City Tuesday, game two was cancelled due to inclement weather ... The Tomcats dropped a pair of non-conference games at Ursuline Wednesday, losing 12-5 and

12-4 before falling in a pair of PAC contests at home to W&J Saturday 11-2 and 17-15 ... In game one against W&J, senior C **Katie Walker** and senior 1B **Jen Stiveson** each finished 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored...Trailing 8-0 after two innings in game two, Thiel exploded for 10 runs in the third to assume an 10-8 lead ... The Tomcats plated five more runs in fifth to go up 15-9, but the Presidents responded with eight runs in the bottom of the fifth.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents posted a 5-2 record this past week, including three straight wins in league play to lock up the No. 3 seed in the PAC Tournament ... Sophomore **Tanesha Minney** and freshman **Valerie Schultz** both hit three-run home runs in the sweep of Frostburg State ... Sophomore LF **Ally Stasik** was 3-for-3 with two RBI in game

one, while junior SS **Stacey Bugle** went 3-for-4 with three RBI ... Minney and Spisak both hit homers in the win at GCC on Friday ... The Presidents racked up 28 runs on 36 hits in the sweep of Thiel on Saturday ... Bugle collected six hits and five RBI in the twinbill ... Bugle has two RBI on Sunday at Allegheny and sophomore catcher **Hannah Schulz** provided the only W&J run in game one with a solo homer ... Freshman P **Rebecca Nachreiner** was 2-1 on the week.



Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans posted a 5-1 mark last week, including a doubleheader sweep of Waynesburg (3-1 and 3-2 in 10 innings) which clinched the second seed for this week's PAC Tournament ... Westminster also swept Penn State-Altoona (8-0, 8-0) and split with Hiram (7-1 win, 7-6 loss) in non-league action ... Junior P Jennifer Pancake fired a two-hitter in the PS-A opener for her fifth straight shutout ... Senior Kat Parfitt got the win in game two ... Hiram snapped Pancake's streak of innings without allowing an earned run at 49 2/3 in the

opener ... Senior 2B **Abby Mazar** was 3-for-4 with three RBIs in game one, while junior 1B **Kristin Zyskowski** was 3-for-3 with two doubles in game two.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City wrapped up the week with its first sweep of Bethany in six years Saturday ... Freshman SS **Amy Fisher** went 5-for-6 with three runs scored ... Senior P **Sarah Smith** earned the Game One win, allowing one

earned run in seven innings ... In the nightcap, the Wolverines hammered five extra-base hits ... Junior CF Paula Rice homered and doubled while Fisher, junior LF Kristy Bogusz and sophomore C Abby Greiner also doubled ... Junior 2B Andrea Settle went 2-for-3 with two RBIs ... Rice set a new Grove City record with 100 at-bats this year ... Her 39 hits are the second-most in GCC history ... Freshman P Julia Coulombe picked up the victory, permitting three earned runs in seven innings.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More clinched the top seed in the PAC tournament with a sweep of Waynesburg Friday ... TMC's start-

ers – Danielle Baer and Jamie Wisenall – didn't allow a single runner past second base in the sweep ... For the week, Baer went 13 innings, allowing no runs and striking out 11 ... Senior **Stephanie Frondorf** went 5-for-12 with a double, a triple and three RBI ... Senior **Becky Horn** had a team-high five RBI for the week.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg finished the regular season with a busy eight-game week, posting a 3-5 record in four doubleheaders ... The Yellow Jackets opened the week with a spit against La Roche before sweeping both games from Grove City Wednesday ... However, WC was then swept in a pair of doubleheaders over the weekend, losing to Tho-

mas More and Westminster ... 3B **Monica Miller** led the offense with a .346 average (9-for-26) with a pair of doubles and seven RBI last week ... Leadoff hitter SS **Haley Kramer** belted her first two collegiate home runs last week and scored a team-best six runs ... Despite boasting a team-ERA of 1.86 in 56.1 innings, the Yellow Jackets struggled defensively, allowing 19 unearned runs on 19 errors.
