Dorazio ended her sophomore season by hitting .636 (7-for-11) in just three games played. She led the team in four runs scored, one triple, two home runs, a slugging percentage of 1.364 and an on-base percentage of .636. She also drove in five runs. The second-year outfielder had maybe her best collegiate game ever on Sunday during a 9-7 loss to W&J. Dorazio went 4-for-4 with two home runs, five RBI and three runs scored against the Presidents.

**TOURNAMENT TIME:** Saint Vincent still has one conference regular season doubleheader to play against Grove City, but has already clinched the 2012 PAC regular season softball crown ... Saint Vincent will open play on Thursday at 11 a.m. against #4 seed Geneva, followed by the other opening round contest between #2 Thiel and #3 Westminster at 1 p.m.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Thomas More's **Brittany Wegman** batted .556 as she was 5-for-9 with two home runs, four runs batted-in, scored four runs, and walked five times on the week ... Saint Vincent head coach **Nicole Hinerman** earned her 100th career win with a doubleheader sweep of Westminster ... W&J's **Paige Deley** had five extra base hits last week.

**AROUND THE PAC:** Kristen Moreland went seven innings and got the 3-2 win over Thomas More, securing Thiel's spot in the PAC tournament ... Geneva had a pair of three run homers from **Christina Fuqua** and **Mackenzie Kemerer** against W&J ... Westminster's **Carly Leffakis** earned a 6-3 win over Bethany only giving up three runs off of seven hits.

## Bethany Bison (13-24, 8-10 PAC)



Bethany won five of six games last week ... **Kiersten Conwell** lifted BC to sweep over Grove City, throwing a two hit shutout in 7-0 win and then allowing one run on six hits in 7-1 victory ... In wins over Marietta, **Maddy Coffey** went 4-for-5 with three RBI in the doubleheader and **Maria Vallone** won game one with RBI single in bottom of the seventh for 2-1 win ... **Heidi Soriano** threw five 1/3 innings in game two to earn her first career win and Emily Jump, who won game one, earned the save in the nightcap ... BC scored six runs in final two innings to pull out 11-5 win at Westminster in game one Sunday ... **Liz Kletzli** was 4-for-4 with two RBI and Vallone had two hits and scored four runs.

## Chatham Cougars (13-23, 3-15 PAC)



Chatham split the first pair of games with Waynesburg with a run difference each game ... The Cougars recorded school history after Game one with their 10<sup>th</sup> win of the season ... **Anne Marie Brnardic** pitched in the 2-1 game ... She allowed five hits, struck out four and retired the final seven Waynesburg batters of the game ... **Alex Miklos** and **Jenn Stefano** each recorded two hits ... **Elizabeth Deckelman** and **Natalie Vazquez** each tallied one ... Miklos and Deckelman had the earned runs ... The Cougars weren't as lucky in the 5-4 loss to Waynesburg ... Miklos started off the game with a double and earned run ... Chatham then took off with a 4-0 lead by the fifth inning ... Waynesburg reciprocated by clearing the bases with a double.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (27-17, 11-7 PAC)



Geneva qualified for the PAC tournament coming up this weekend ... Geneva opened the week with a sweep at W&J that was highlighted by a pair of three run homers from **Christina Fuqua** and **Mackenzie Kemerer** ... Geneva split a doubleheader with Thomas More one day later that included a solo shot off of **Ashley Davis'** bat ... After dropping the first game 4-2 in extra innings, Geneva exploded for a 10-2 win over the Saints in the night cap ... On Friday, Geneva's offense went into shut-down mode but managed to take advantage of more outstanding **Julie DiLorenzo** pitching with a 1-0 victory in game one against Chatham.

## Grove City Wolverines (18-20, 6-10 PAC)



Grove City's hopes of qualifying for the PAC tournament dissipated with a pair of setbacks at Bethany ... In Game Two, freshman 3B **Allison Rayburn** went 2-for-3 for the Wolverines while **Elsa Klingensmith** doubled and singled ... Grove City will write the final chapter of the conference's regular season Monday when the Wolverines host Saint Vincent in a doubleheader ... The games had been scheduled for Saturday but poor weather forced a 48-hour postponement ... Grove City will honour seniors **Elizabeth Covatto**, **Allison Eastham**, **Grace Murtoff** and **Sarah Young** prior to the doubleheader ... The Wolverines must win both games to remain in contention for a possible ECAC Tournament invite.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (23-13, 12-4 PAC)



The Bearcats clinched at least a share of the regular season PAC crown and hosting rights for the 2012 PAC tournament with a doubleheader sweep of Westminster (1-0, 6-3) this week ... Head coach **Nicole Hinerman** won her 100<sup>th</sup> game ... In the first game against the Titans, **Emily Lauterbach** tossed her third complete-game shutout of the season ... She improved to 9-3 on the season with the win. SVC scratched across the game's only run in the fourth inning as **Maria Adams** led off with a walk and advanced to second on a sac bunt ... **Shannon Baczek** then connected on an RBI double to bring home Adams ... In the nightcap, SVC posted five runs on four extra-base hits in the third inning.

## Thiel Tomcats (18-18, 11-7 PAC)



Thiel went 2-2 last week in conference play, splitting double headers with W&J and Thomas More ... In the 6-4 win over W&J, **Becky Betteridge** went 1-for-4 with three RBI on the day while **Molly Jo Everett** went 2-for-3 with an RBI ... **Danielle Massengill** was 1-for-3 that included a triple, which marked her eighth of the season, putting her first in the Tomcat record books for most triples in a season ... In the 3-2 win over Thomas More, once again Massengill paced the Tomcats offensively, going 2-for-3 with an RBI while teammate **Ashley Rable** went 2-for-4 ... **Kristen Moreland** went seven innings and got the win, striking out nine batters and allowing three walks.

## Thomas More Saints (23-17, 10-8 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-2 with splits with Geneva and Thiel ... The Saints had two players bat over .500 as **Brittany Wegman** batted .556 as she was 5-for-9 with two home runs, four runs batted-in, four runs scored and was walked five times and **Alex Walter** batted .500 as she was 7-for-14 with three doubles and two RBI ... **Ronni Burns** led the Saints in the circle last week as she was 1-1 with a 2.84 earned run average as she pitched 24.2 innings and gave up 10 runs (all earned) on 27 hits and struck out 22 ... For the season, Wegman leads the team at the plate with a .475 batting average as she is 48-of-101 with eight doubles, eight home runs, 30 RBI and 29 runs scored.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-21, 9-9 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson concluded its conference slate with a 2-4 week against PAC competition ... The Presidents improved their win total by eight from last spring and tied for the second-most conference victories in school history with nine ... All five of freshman first baseman **Paige Deley's** hits went for extra bases last week ... Deley leads the team with a .348 batting average ... The Presidents have hit 11 home runs this spring, compared to just two last year ... W&J has scored 67 more runs than it did last spring (158-91) ... Sophomore pitcher **Madison Rotto's** nine victories in the circle are the most by a Presidents' pitcher since Rebecca Nachreiner won 18 in 2008.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (18-18, 7-11 PAC)



Waynesburg split with W&J and Chatham ... After dropping game one by the final score of 2-1 against the Cougars, the Jackets bounced back with a come-from-behind 5-4 victory that took 10 innings to complete ... A 10<sup>th</sup>-inning double by **Rachael Moon** posted the game-winning run in the late contest, but it only happened after **Jasmine Blackwell** smacked a three-run double in the seventh to force extra innings ... Moving to Saturday, Waynesburg led 4-3 going into the bottom of the sixth before the Presidents responded with six runs to take a 9-4 lead ... Game two was a totally different story as **Jenn Lingg** threw a five-inning two-hitter for the win.

## Westminster Titans (21-17, 11-7 PAC)



The Lady Titans finished the regular season as the No. 3 seed in the 2012 PAC Tournament and will play No. 2 seed Thiel on Thursday ... Westminster is vying for their first PAC title since 2005 ... Last week, the Titans went 1-3, and were swept by Saint Vincent (1-0 and 6-3) ... The Lady Titans went on to split with Bethany in their last doubleheader of the regular season ... Bethany won game one, 11-5, and the Titans won game two, 6-3 ... In game two, **Carly Leffakis** earned the win after she gave up three runs off of seven hits ... Westminster scored four runs in the second inning as **Kelsey Squelch** hit a two-RBI single and **Erica Kimmick** hit a two-RBI double.
