The Saints and Westminster have each clinched tournament berths, with the final spot likely to be decided by Tuesday's doubleheader between Grove City and Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison (25-13, 13-1 PAC)



Bethany took over first place in the PAC by winning all eight conference games last week, including a sweep of Thomas More Friday ... The week started with 7-5 (14 inn.) and 6-3 wins at Waynesburg, as **Cortney Lax** had five hits and three RBIs ... The Bison rolled on with 4-2 and 6-1 triumphs over Chatham, as **Andrea Thomas** was 6-for-8 with six RBIs ... The TMC sweep was highlighted by strong pitching, as a Thomas solo homer and **Emily Jump**'s three-hit shutout boosted BC to a 1-0 win on game 1 ... **Cortney Newland** then fired a three-hitter in the nightcap and **Kristina Massie**'s two-run triple highlighted a four-run second in the 4-1 Bison win ... The week ended with 4-1 and 9-1 wins at W&J.

Chatham Cougars (9-18, 3-13 PAC)



The Cougars had a full week this week, facing off against Westminster, Bethany, Waynesburg, and St. Vincent in PAC doubleheaders in the final week of regular season competition ... Visiting Westminster out-hit the Cougars to secure both victories and sweep the series ... On the road at Bethany, Chatham wasn't able to tally enough hits or score enough runs to defeat the Bison, who won by scores of 4-2 and 6-1 ... Waynesburg handed Chatham two more losses on Friday - 11-1 and 8-0 - including their second shut-out loss of the season ... Finally, on Saturday, Chatham finished out their regular season games on Saturday at St. Vincent, where they split a pair of contests with the Bearcats.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (25-11)



Geneva posted a 5-1 record last week, including a marathon 13-inning victory at Waynesburg Saturday ... The GTs swept doubleheaders from Penn State-Beaver and Thiel before splitting a pair with Waynesburg ... **Ariel Lilly** picked up two victories in the circle including a complete game, shut-out against Thiel ... It took 13 innings for Geneva to defeat Waynesburg in game one of their doubleheader Saturday ... The Golden Tornadoes exploded for five runs in the top of the 13th to get the victory ... Earlier in the week, **Martha Adams** came up with a walk-off double as Geneva held off Penn State-Beaver 4-3 ... The Golden Tornadoes finished the regular season with an overall record of 25-11.

After dropping the opener 4-2, Grove City earned a 9-1 win in game two ... **Casey Schmidt** went 3-for-4 with a double in the nightcap, while **Grace Murtoff** and **Amanda Shepeck** both went 2-for-3 ... Winning pitcher **Lauren Pennell** also doubled ... Thursday, Grove City split a twinbill with visiting Penn State Behrend ... **Lauren Clarke** threw a two-hit shutout in the opener.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (15-11, 5-9 PAC)



The Bearcats split doubleheaders with Chatham (Sat) and Thiel (Sun) ... In Saturday's opener with the Cougars, freshman **Becky Deane** hit a game-tying solo homer in the seventh to send the game into extra frames, before winning the game with an RBI single in the bottom of the ninth ... She went 4-for-4 with a walk, in support of SP **Shauna Hetrick**, who earned the complete game win by scattering six hits with no walks, and striking out five ... In the nightcap, SVC jumped out to a 3-0 lead after three frames, but saw the Cougars score two runs in each the fifth and sixth innings for the comeback win ... SVC managed just seven hits in the loss, with two apiece from **Alyssa Grossman** and **Maria Adams**.

Thiel Tomcats (10-21, 6-8 PAC)

In their 3-2 game two win against Saint Vincent Sunday, **Emily Batiz** earned the win in the circle allowing two runs on six hits with six strikeouts ... **Melissa Rankin** finished 1-for-3 with three RBIs while Rable went 2-for-3 with a run scored.
