Game A - New Wilmington, PA - May 4 - 11 a.m. #1 Westminster 5, #4 Bethany 2

The top-seeded Lady Titans scored once in the first and twice in the second for an early 3-0 lead. Bethany used a pair of infield hits coupled with a Westminster error to cut the lead to 3-2 in the third, only to see the Titans add insurance tallies in the fourth and fifth innings. For Westminster, senior P Jennifer Pancake (Boardman, OH/Boardman H.S.) earned the win, allowing one earned run on five hits with seven strikeouts. Sophomore 3B Amy Cornicelli (Warren, OH/Howland H.S.) and freshman 1B Jennifer Emery (New Castle, PA/Laurel H.S.) each posted a pair of hits in the win for WC, while senior OF Kristin Zyskowski (Coraopolis, PA/Montour H.S.) added a triple. For the Bison, junior P Heather Immesberger (Rumson, NJ/Rumson Fair Haven H.S.) went the distance in the loss, striking out two. Freshman 2B Jamie Petrel (Burgettstown, PA/Burgettstown H.S.) paced the BC offense by going 2-for-3 with a pair of doubles in defeat.

Game B - New Wilmington, PA - May 4 - 1 p.m.

#3 Thomas More 1, #2 Washington & Jefferson 0

A pitcher's dual between Saint junior Jamie Wisenall (Morning View, KY/Simon Kenton H.S.) and President sophomore Rebecca Nachreiner (Pittsburgh, PA/North Hills H.S.) was decided in the fifth inning when Thomas More plated the game's only run. Sophomore 2B Jenna Kelsch (Foster, KY/Pendleton County H.S.) opened the frame with a double, then scored on a two-out single by sophomore C Kaycee Bischoff (Hebron, KY/Conner H.S.). Wisenall scattered four hits while striking out five in the shutout win for TMC, while Nachreiner took the hard-luck loss despite also allowing just four hits while recording 11 strikeouts. Junior OF Ally Stasik (Bridgeville, PA/South Fayette H.S.) paced W&J at the plate with a 2-for-3 performance.

Game C - New Wilmington, PA - May 4 - 3 p.m. #3 Thomas More 4, #1 Westminster 1

After batlling through five scoreless innings, Thomas More took control with a four-run sixth inning. Westminster answered with an unearned run in the bottom of the frame, but could get no closer as the Saints advanced to Saturday's PAC championship game. Junior P Michelle Farler (Frankfort, KY/Franklin County H.S.) led TMC by scattering four hits while strikeing out three. Offensively, Thomas More senior 3B Kim Kreimer (Cincinnati, OH/Anderson

H.S.) led the way by going 2-for-3 with a double, while Farler helped her own cause with a two-run single. For Westminster, senior P **Jennifer Pancake (Boardman, OH/Boardman H.S.)** took the loss after allowing four runs (three earned) while striking out five. Sophomore 3B **Amy Cornicelli (Warren, OH/Howland H.S.)** scored the lone run for the Titans following a TMC error.

Game D - New Wilmington, PA - May 4 - 5:10 p.m. #2 Washington & Jefferson 9, #4 Bethany 1 (6 inns.)

The Presidents pounded out 11 hits and took advantage of four Bison errors to eliminate Bethany from the tournament. Sophomore Rebecca Nachreiner (Pittsburgh, PA/North Hills H.S.) earned the pitching win for W&J, allowing one run on four hits with six strikeouts. Three President hitters - junior OFs Amanda Howard (Wexford, PA/North Allegheny H.S.) and Ally Stasik (Bridgeville, PA/South Fayette H.S.) along with junior DH Tanesha Minney (Houston, PA/Chartiers-Houston H.S.) - collected two hits each. Sophomore Brittni Doerfer (Lakeville, OH/West Holmes H.S.) took the pitching loss for Bethany, while freshman 1B Bridgette Fauth (Pittsburgh, PA/Carrick H.S.) doubled and scored in the loss for the Bison.

Game E - New Wilmington, PA - May 5 - 11 a.m. #2 Washington & Jefferson 5, #1 Westminster 0

The Presidents took a 1-0 lead in the fourth, then added four insurance tallies in the fifth to eliminate the top-seeded Titans from the tournament. W&J sophomore P Rebecca Nachreiner (Pittsburgh, PA/North Hills H.S.) scattered seven hits with no walks and three strikeouts to post the complete game shutout. At the plate, the Presidents were paced by junior DH Tanesha Minney (Houston, PA/Chartiers-Houston H.S.), who went 2-for-3 with a double, while sophomore 1B Valerie Schultz (Washington, PA/McGuffey H.S.) added an RBI double as W&J advanced to the PAC title game against Thomas More. For Westminster, senior P Jennifer Pancake (Boardman, OH/Boardman H.S.) took the loss, allowing two earned runs with two strikeouts. Pancake and sophomore 3B Amy Cornicelli (Warren, OH/Howland H.S.) each doubled in defeat.

Game F - New Wilmington, PA - May 5 - 1 p.m. #3 Thomas Mor 3, #2 Washington & Jefferson 1

The Saints posted single runs in the first, third and sixth innings en route to capturing their first-ever PAC softball crown. TMC junior P Jamie Wisenall (Morning View, KY/Simon Kenton H.S.) earned the complete game win in the title game, allowing one run on five hits with four strikeouts. At the plate, senior SS Stacy Barry (Alexandria, KY/Campbell County H.S.) paced the victors by going 2-for-3 with a double. W&J, the defending PAC softball champion, saw sophomore 1B Valerie Schultz (Washington, PA/McGuffey H.S.) record an RBI triple. Taking the pitching loss was junior P Kelsey Donahue (North Springfield, PA/Northwestern H.S.), who gave up two earned runs on five hits with a pair of strikeouts.
