Grove City looks to carry it's non-conference domination into the PAC, while Bethany looks for its first conference win.

NEWS & NOTES: The Titan women touched first in eight events and the Titan men captured five events against Rollins ... Senior Emily Dessler and sophomore Caitlin Lehberger were Westminster's multi-event winners ... Dressler took the 200 (1:58.68) and 500 (5:18.40) freestyle races ... W&J diver Bethany Haver set a pool record with her 11-dive performance on the 1-meter board ... Haver notched 366.85 points to set the 20-yr. record.

The Presidents earned their third dual-meet sweep of the year on Saturday when posting wins over Saint Vincent ... Sophomore diver **Bethany Haver** set a pool record with her 11-dive performance on the 1-meter board ... Haver notched 366.85 points to set a record



which had stood for over 20 years ... Senior Mark Sirkoch had four victories for the men's squad ... He helped the 200 medley relay team open with a victory in 1:42.54 and then touched first in the 100 (1:04.26) and 200 (2:22.64) breaststroke events ... Sirkoch concluded his day as a member of the winning 200 freestyle relay squad (1:31.09) ... Freshman Jami Andrews also had a big day for the W&J women with three wins ... She swam a leg on the opening 200 medley relay win (1:56.81) before collecting victories in the 100 (1:13.60) and 200 (2:40.07) breaststrokes ... The other multiple-event winner for the Titan women was senior Emily Dressler taking the 200 (1:58.68) and 500 (5:18.40) freestyle races ...
