Bethany Bison

The Bison fell to 0-3 on the year with losses at Baldwin-Wallace... Despite a 114-80 loss, Bethany's men received a great effort from **Kenko Nagai**, who touched first in three events, including the 200 IM (2:03.86), 100 Butterfly (53.12) and 100 Breaststroke (59.52)... Freshman **Joe Kennedy** won the one-meter diving event and freshman **Damien Sanzotti** finished second in the 50 Free and 100 Free... The women's team was paced by freshman **Dana Culbert**, who won a pair of events, including the 50 Free (26.43) and 100 Free (57.57)... Freshman **Katie Raynovich** also claimed a first, tying for the top spot in the 200 Free (2:14.95)... Junior **Emily Young** placed second in the 500 and 1000 Frees.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Carnegie Mellon swept a dual meet from Washington & Jefferson in swimming and diving action on Saturday afternoon at the Henry Memorial Natatorium ... The CMU women defeated W&J, 136-83, while the Tartan men knocked off the W&J men, 134-79 ... The loss was the first of the season for the W&J women (4-1), while the men's team fell to 3-2 overall ... Junior **Vanessa Tome** picked up the lone victory for the women's squad as she claimed the 100 breaststroke in a time of 1:13.10 ... Sophomore **Abby Leslie** posted two second-place finishes, earning runner-up laurels in the 50 freestyle (27.87) and the 1-meter diving (235.00 points) events ... Junior **Chris Shively** posted the W&J men's only first-place finish by winning the 50 freestyle (22.68) ... He also placed second in the 100 freestyle in a time of 51.28 ... Sophomore **Andrew Pratt** also placed second in the 100 backstroke (57.68) ... The Presidents return to action next Saturday as they host Grove City on Senior Recognition Day at 1 pm.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverine swim teams prepare for their second conference meet of the season Saturday in Washington ... Grove City has not been in action since Dec. 12 when the men and women swept Bethany ... Both GCC teams own two-meet win streaks over Washington and Jefferson.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster College men's and women's swimming teams each dropped non-conference dual meets to NCAA Division I member University of North Carolina on Jan. 3 in Phoenix, AZ ... The Titan men suffered their first dual defeat of the year, falling to 2-1 after a 35-28 loss to the Tar Heels, while the Lady Titans fell to 1-2 after also losing to UNC 35-28 ... Although no Westminster swimmers won an event, several posted outstanding performances against Division I competition ... For the men, seniors **Seth Bontrager** and **Craig Guthoerl** and junior **Matt Buzard** each posted a pair of Top Three finishes in individual events, while also swimming legs for a second-place 200 medley relay team ... The Lady Titans had senior **Stefanie King** and junior **Brittany Jardine** also posted a pair of Top Three individual finishes while swimming for a second-place 200 medley relay unit ... Westminster swimming returns to action on Friday, Jan. 17, as the Titans and Lady Titans travel to Meadville for a non-conference dual meet at Allegheny College at 7 p.m.
